To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions  
of Bedford County Pa.

The petition of the Undersigned citizens  
of Bradford Township Bedford County Pa. Respectfully repre-  
sent that at September Sessions 1880 a petition was presented  
for the appointment of Viewers to view and vacate that part  
of a Township road, which has been laid out and opened  
leading from Clay Pike near Woodland brick works, (lower end)  
to James Parks in said township. - upon the alleged reason  
that the same was useless inconvenient and burdensome  
to the inhabitants of said Township.

That viewers were appointed  
who report in favor of vacating the following courses and  
distances, Beginning at intersection of the road leading to  
Woodland near James Parks House. thence N 18 per. N 66 deg W  
14½ per N 44 deg W 8 per, N 29 deg W 26 per N 44 deg W 9½ per N 26 deg  
W 11 per N 49 deg E 18 per N 7 per to the Pump Pike. That the  
said Report was confirmed N. S. at any Term 1881.

Your peti-  
tioners Respectfully represent that this part of the road as  
vacated is not inconvenient, nor useless, and that the  
same cannot be very burdensome, ~~for~~ that the same  
is as reported by the Viewers but 1.12 Rods long. And  
they ~~would~~ further represent that this is the  
only road by which the Bedford Fire Bricks  
can haul their Fire clay, from their mines  
on the lands of Thomas Parks to their siding  
for transportation to their works, and that

the said company have heretofore kept this road in repair, almost entirely at their own expense and further that this road has been in use for many years and has been a great convenience to the citizens living in a portion of the southern part of Bradford & northern part of Boggs townships and they therefore pray for an order of review of the same.
