Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the
County of Charfield.

The petition of Shadrach
Stanley; Rev. W. Stanley; Samuel Whitesides;
Jacob Ginter; Alex. Ream; W. H. Edwards;
James Flynn and A. Flynn respectfully
represents: That a private road beginning
at the road leading from the East end of
Kulich Township, commonly called the road
through the "Ginter Settlement" to the Philipsturg
road, through the lands of R. B. McCully or on
the line between R. B. McCully; Rev. Stanley; Cath-
erine Wilson; Alex. Ream and Mrs. Scott has
been laid out by the order of the said Court
in the said Township of Kulich. And as it is
the desire of your petitioners that said road
may be opened for private use, and as some per-
sons through whose lands said road passes
may sustain damage by reason of the open-
ing of the same. Your petitioners therefore pray
your Honors to appoint six disinterested per-
sons to view the premises and assess the dama-
ges which parties living along the line of said
road may sustain by reason of the opening
of the same and they will ever pray &c.
