To the Honorable the Judges of Said Court.
The Petition of The Subscribers Citizens of
Bell Township Clearfield Co respectfully
Represents

That a petition was presented to June
sessions 1881 praying the Court to appoint
~~proper~~ persons to view and lay out a
Road to lead from the old Susquehanna
road at a point near the Rock Spring School
House to intersect a Public Road at or
near Daniel Foyers on a road leading to
Touberville, which was accordingly done and
said viewers Reported in favor, and did lay
out said road which was confirmed nisi
at June Session 1882.

Your petitioners verily believe that if
the Court confirm said report it would
do great injuries to the citizens of said
township.

Your petitioners therefore Pray that the Court
refuse to confirm said report and they will
ever pray that said road is laid out over
swampy and rocky ground and with too steep
grades, is a longer distance than a Public
Road long in use between ~~Said~~ points, would
be inconvenient and burdensome and is not
necessary for public use.
