the County of Clearfield.

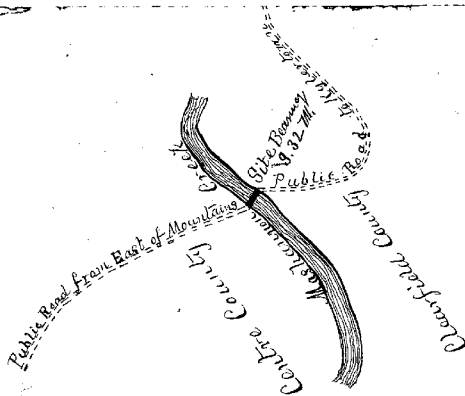
We the subscribers appointed by the
order of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Clearfield County to view the place propos-
ed for a bridge over Moshannon Creek
where the public road to the east of the
mountains crosses said creek at the
place known as 'Pioneer Mills' in Mor-
ris Township, respectfully report: -

That all the viewers appointed by said
court having been present and having all
been severally sworn or affirmed ac-
cording to law we have viewed the prem-
ises and are of opinion that a bridge
over Moshannon Creek where the public
highway to the east of the mountain
crosses said creek is necessary, and
that said bridge should be erected
on the sight of the old bridge, bearing
south thirty-two Degrees west, and that
the erecting of such bridge would be at-
tended with more expense than it is
reasonable said township should bear.

ROAD VIEWERS' REPORT.

Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 4th day of Oct, A. D. 1881, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Morris, in said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a ~~road or highway~~ leading from Bridge over Moshannon Creek at the place where the Public road to the east of the mountains crosses said Creek, and at what is known as the Pioneer mills in the Township aforesaid

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law. Whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint James Mitchell Saul I Burge and J S Stewart, who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ ^{Bridge}, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ ^{Bridge}, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a ~~road~~ ^{Bridge}, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private ~~road~~ ^{Bridge}, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the ~~courses and distances, with reference to the improvements through which it may pass,~~ to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. By the Court.
