To the Hon Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

The undersigned citizens of Decatur
Township Clearfield County respectfully
petition the Court to grant them
a review on a road recently laid
out in said township purporting to
commence on road leading from Philips-
burg to Osceola and terminate at the road
leading from the Old Turnpike to
Clearfield Creek on lands of Campbell^{2d}
brother and suggest the following rea-
sons for a review.

1st The road is not laid out on the
route or over the lands asked for in
the petition—

2nd There was no notice given to owners
and occupants along said route of
the time and place of view.

3rd That great damage will result
to owners of the land through which
this Road is laid out if the road be
opened on this route.

4th That the road as laid out will
be more expensive to the Township
by reason of damages to adjoining
occupants and is not as good a grade
or on as good ground for a road as could

be selected to accommodate the public.
