To the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of Cleburn County Ky.

The petition of the Subscribers respectfully represents that a road was formerly laid out by order of the Court from the Snoguehanna river near Merriam's forks in Greenwood Township to Township road near J. Priestley Ropes in the same Township. Beginning at the Snoguehanna river thence about two miles to Harvey McCrackens thence about one half a mile to the Township road near J. W. Ropes that the road is now opened from said McCrackens to said Ropes and that it answers every purpose for which the view was granted. Your petitioners therefore conceive that the road between the river and the said McCrackens is useless inconvenient and burdensome. Your petitioners therefore pray the Court that the same road may be vacated
