To the Honorable the Judges within named.

We the undersigned appointed by the annexed order of Court to view the premises and assess the damages if any that the different proprietors would sustain by reason of the said street being opened as mentioned in said order do respectfully report: That we met for the purpose of performing the duties imposed upon us by the said order at Glen Hope, Pa on the 20th day of February, A.D. 1883, and after having been severally sworn or affirmed according to law and after having viewed the properties different proprietors through which the said street passes and have carefully taken into consideration the damages sustained by the different parties through whom runs the said street is to be opened as also the advantage to be derived from such passage and it is our opinion as regards the property of J. L. Glasgow that the advantages to the property derived from the opening of said street is equal to any damage that the property may have sustained by reason thereof. Consequently assess no damages for the land owner, nor thereon for contribution.

And we are also of the same opinion in regard to the several properties viz. that of E. A. Whiter, John McWright, Presbyterian Church property, Calist. Coopers and therefore assess no damages on either of the properties for the land owners, nor thereon for contribution.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the
Peace of the County of Clearfield, held
at Clearfield, in and for said County,
on the Eighteenth day of January
A.D. 1883, before Judges of said Court
upon a petition of the Burgess and
Town Council of the Borough of Glen

Hope, in said County setting forth that the citizens
of said Borough labor under great inconvenience
for want of a Street to run from the Methodist Epis-
-copal Church property on Front Street to intersect
Pine Street, (by the nearest and best route) in said
Borough, which proposed Street it is desired shall
be called "Church Street" and which they are about
to open; And therefore praying the Court to appoint
Seven disinterested freeholders of said Borough to
view the premises and report upon the same, and
upon the damages or assessment if any, where-
-upon the Court, after due consideration had
of the premises do order and appoint J. W. Bratton,
Samuel Hegarty, Robert Hunter, George Berger, R. J.
Rex, Joshua Constock and Levi Baco who after
being first respectively sworn or affirmed to perform
the duties of their appointment according to law
with impartiality and fidelity shall proceed to
view the premises described in said petition, hav-
-ing regard to both the advantages and disad-
-vantages caused to the several properties along
the line of and adjoining said Street and alley,
and shall assess and allow to all persons injured
thereby, such damages as they shall have sus-
-tained respectively, over and above all advantages;
and shall also make assessments for contribution
upon all such properties as shall be benefited by
the opening of said Street, such sums respectively, as
they may have been benefited over and above all
disadvantages and shall make report of their pro-
-ceedings in writing to the next Session of said
Court, describing the properties upon which as-
