We the undersigned persons
appointed by said Court to view the
place for proposed bridge across Little
Clearfield Creek, respectfully, report:
That having given notice by printed hand-
bills of the time and place of said view
we were all present on the day ap-
pointed - to wit: the 8th of December 1883
and having been severally sworn and
affirmed, in pursuance of said order
we viewed the premises aforesaid and
are of opinion that a bridge over Little
Clearfield Creek at its mouth, on the site
of the old bridge, ~~is necessary~~ where the
public road crosses the said Creek, is
necessary, and that the erecting of such a
bridge would be attended with more expense
than it is reasonable the said Townships of Law-
rence & Boggs should bear, and that the cost
to the County of erecting said bridge should not
exceed Twelve hundred dollars.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield held at Clearfield in and for said County on the 16th day of June 1883 before the Judges of said Court upon the petition of ~~John~~ Bach Ogden and others sundry Inhabitants of the Townships of Rogge and Lawrence setting forth that the bridge formerly erected and constructed over Little Clearfield Creek at James Forest in said Township has fallen down and is a complete wreck that said Bridge connected the Townships of Rogge & Lawrence that it is necessary that a bridge should be erected over said Creek as soon as possible for the traveling public that said Bridge will cost about twelve hundred dollars and such expences are too heavy and burdensome for the Township or Townships to bear and therefore they pray the Court to appoint Viewers to view the premises and report thereof to the Court whether such bridge is necessary and too expensive for the Townships of Rogge and Lawrence to erect alone or whether the County Commissioners may erect the same as required by act of Assembly in such case made and provided

Whereupon the Court after due consideration do order and appoint Wm D Bigler & H Moore and Asgar Bloom who after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointments with impartiality are to view the ground proposed for said bridge they shall make report to the next Court of

Quarter Sessions to be held at Clearfield in
which report they shall state that they have
been sworn or affirmed according to law
