Order to View

State of Pennsylvania }
County of Clearfield } SS

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield held at Clearfield in and for said County on the 15th day of December A.D. 1884, before the Judges of the same, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the Townships of Bloom & Union in said County respectfully represents;—

That the line between the said townships as now established is so located that one corner of said township of Bloom is left without proper and convenient access to the School House of said township or to other points thereof, And the convenience of the inhabitants of said township would be greatly promoted by altering the line between the said townships as follows viz:— To begin at the point where the line between said townships of Bloom & Union strikes Little Anderson or Big Anderson Creek thence along and up said Little Anderson Creek to the point where the Cream Hill turnpike road crosses said Little Anderson Creek, thence along said Cream Hill turnpike road to the line of Brady Township— Balance of the line to remain as heretofore—

And now 15 Dec/ 1884 Petition read and considered whereupon the Court Appoint Geo. C. Kille Andrew Liddle & Daniel Goodlander— Commissioners who having been duly sworn to perform their duties with fidelity and having given due notice to the inhabitants of said Townships of

1 said townships the time and place of their
2 meeting, are to inquire into the propriety of granting
3 the prayer of the petitioners, and said Commissioners or
4 any two of them are further directed to make a plot or
5 draft of said townships of Bloom and Union "on the
6 division line proposed all of which said Commissioners
7 or any two shall report at our next Court of Quarter
8 Sessions together with their opinion of the same, and
9 their opinion of the propriety of granting the prayer of the
10 petitioners. By the Court

15 To the Honorable, the Judges within named: We the undersigned,
16 a majority of said commissioners, appointed by the
17 annexed order do report; That in pursuance thereof, after
18 having been duly sworn according to law, viewed the
19 premises for the within mentioned change in the line
20 between Bloom and Union townships, in Clearfield
21 County, Pennsylvania. And we do agree that there
22 is occasion for a change of the line between the said
23 townships as desired by the petitioners, and that the
24 same, in our opinion, is necessary for the convenience of
25 the inhabitants of said townships, and that said change
26 is proper and expedient. We have, therefore, laid
27 out and do return as and for a part of said Union
28 township, all that part of the said township of Bloom,
29 to wit:— Beginning at a point where the line between
30 said Bloom and Union townships crosses Big Anderson
31 Creek; thence down said Big Anderson Creek, its

several Courses and distances to the mouth of Little
Anderson creek; thence up said Little Anderson
creek, its several courses and distances to where the
Cream-Hill Turnpike crosses said creek; thence by
said Turnpike, N. 57° W. one hundred and ten (110) perches;
thence still by same, N. 70° W. eighty perches, (80) to a
point in the Brady township line; thence North on
the line between Brady and Bloom townships to the
south-east corner of Warrant No. 3574; thence east, on
the line between said Bloom and Union townships, to
the place of beginning. We further report, that before
said view, public notice of the time and place of the
meeting of the commissioners was given to the inhabitants
of said townships of Bloom and Union, by notices put
up in each of the said townships - ten days before
said meeting, and we annex a plot or draft of that
part of Bloom and Union townships adjacent there-
to and showing that part of the said township of Bloom,
with the improvements, to be adjoined to the said town-
ship of Union, and also showing the present location
of the line between said townships, and the proposed
line.
