Exceptions to Report of viewers in No. 1 Febr'y
Term 1885.

- Third. That the road as laid out is extended beyond the terminus named in the petition and order.
- Fourth. That the termini in the report are not the termini named in the petition and order to view.
- Fifth. That improvements along the line of the road are not noted upon the report or attached draft.
- Sixth. That the owners of the lands through which the road is laid out, are not named in the report or draft.
- Seventh. That such notice was not given as is required by law.

To the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of the Peace, in the annexed order named:

We, the subscribers, the persons appointed
by the said court, to view and lay out
the road therein mentioned, report, that having
been first severally sworn or affirmed, in the
manner and form prescribed by the said order,
that all of us having viewed the ground for the
proposed road, and all concurring, did lay
out, and now return the same for a public
road, beginning at a post near Green Run
Bridge, on the township road running from
Ansonville to Warren, thence South eighty
eight-degrees East, twenty perches, to Birch tree,
thence North fifty two degrees East, thirty five and
two tenths perches, thence North thirty six degrees
East, eighteen and four tenths perches, thence North
thirteen degrees East twenty two perches, thence North
thirty degrees East, eighteen and four tenths perches,
thence North sixty two and one half degrees East, four-
teen and eight tenths perches, thence North seventy
two and one half degrees East twenty two and eight
tenths perches, thence North seventy five degrees
East, fourteen perches, thence East fourteen and
four tenths perches, thence South seventy eight de-
grees East, three and four tenths perches, thence
South seventy six degrees East, twenty perches,
thence South sixty two degrees East, sixteen and
four tenths perches, thence South fifty seven

degrees East, twenty two and four tenths, perches, thence South seventy seven and one half degrees East, twelve perches to the West end of Green Street, in the Village of Gaggam, thence by said Street North seventy three degrees East, sixty perches, thence North four and one half degrees West, fifteen and three tenths perches, thence South eighty seven and one half degrees East, thirty nine and five tenths perches to Water Street, thence by said Street North fifty three degrees East, seventy three perches, thence North twenty one degrees East, thirty five perches to corner of R. Johnston's Land and the present Eastern limit of the village of Gaggam, with reference to the improvements through which it passes, a plot or draft whereof is hereto annexed.

We, the said viewers, further report that representations were made to us, on the day of said view, by petitioners for said road and by other persons interested in it, that a further extension of said road beyond the limits prescribed in said order, a distance of forty five rods, (45 R) in Ferguson Township, to the Ansonville and Lumber City Road would be a great public convenience. And, having viewed the ground, we are of opinion that said road ought to be so extended, and, if consistent with the laws relating to Public Roads, &c, and the rules of your

Honorable Court, respectfully recommend
that said extension be made as follows, viz:

Beginning at corner of R. Johnston's land - the terminus of the said road as viewed and layed out by us thence North sixteen and one half degrees East twenty seven and three tenths rods to a post, thence North one and one half degrees East, seventeen and seven tenths rods to a post on the Ansonville and Lumber City Road.

In the annexed plot we have represented by a dotted line the extension aforesaid.

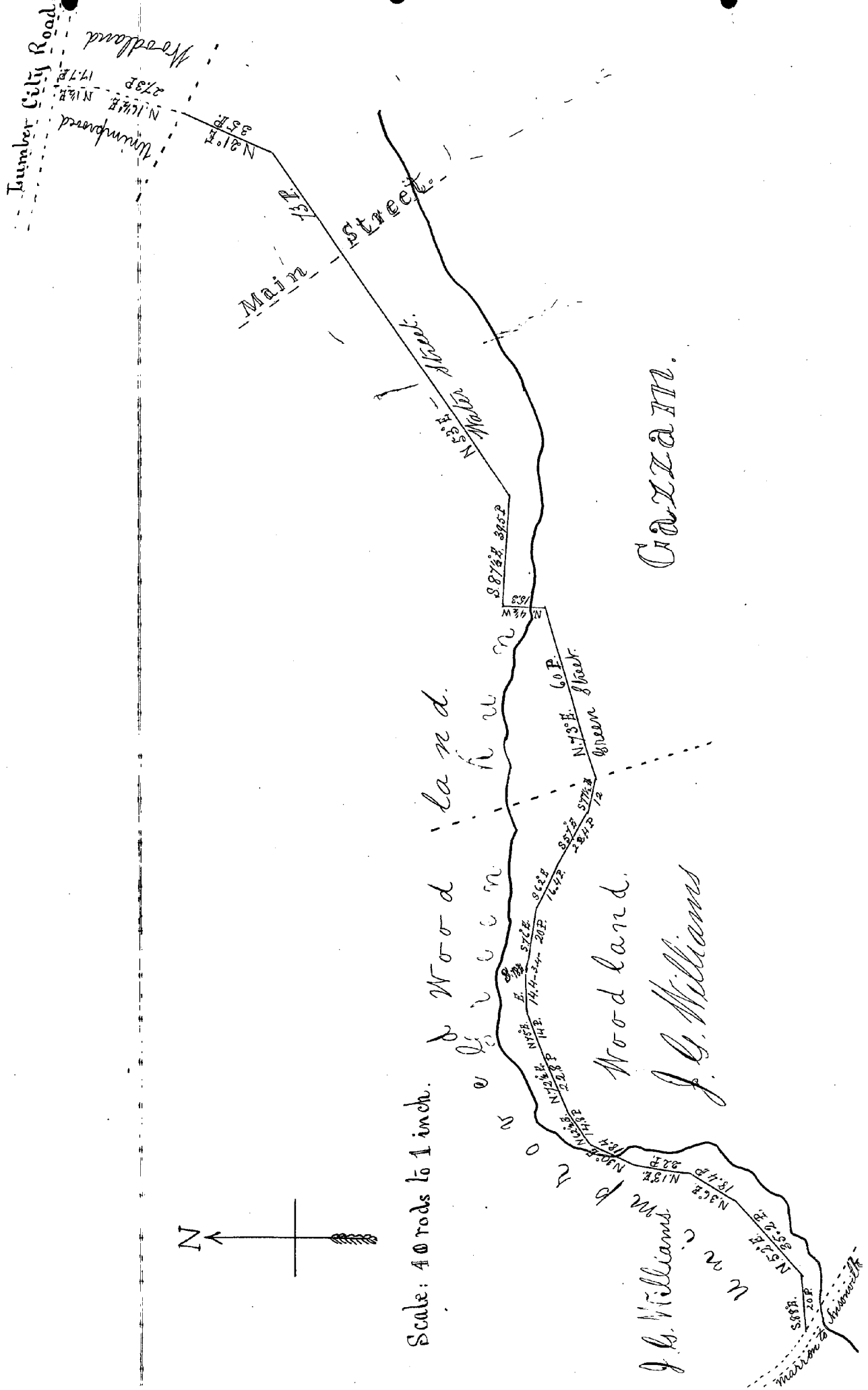

Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the
9th day of Feb'y, A. D. 1885,
before Judges of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhab-
itants of the township of Jordan, in

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

W. J. Nugent, Jr., J. Straw & Christ Straub
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment
with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they
view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road,
they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having
respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do
least injury to private property, and state particularly whether they judge the same necessary
for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and
distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure
releases of damages from persons through whose lands said road may pass, or failing to
procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof
to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county, in which report they shall
state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be
given to the owners or occupants of seated lands through which the within road is intended
to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.
