Clearfield, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the
11th day of May, A. D. 1885,
before Judges of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhab-
itants of the township of Burdside, in
said county, setting forth that they labor under

great inconveniences from want of a public road
beginning at or near the Iron Bridge in
the Borough of Burdside, thence by the nearest
the best route in Burdside Twp. to the County
line between Clearfield & Indiana Counties
at or near the residence of Edward Pearce

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same
according to law, ^{the} Report to next term

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint
Thomas W. Moore, James S. Wetzel & Wm. Holmes
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment
with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they
view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road,
they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having
respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do
least injury to private property, and state particularly whether they judge the same necessary
for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and
distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure
releases of damages from persons through whose lands said road may pass, or failing to
procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof
to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county, in which report they shall
state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be
given to the owners or occupants of seated lands through which the within road is intended
to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the foregoing order of Court. to view the Road therein described. Do Report. that in pursuance of said order and appointment: after first having given notice of the time and place of meeting- by written & printed advertisements put up according to law and also having given due notice to the owners and occupants of lands, through which said road was intended to pass, of the same we all met. and being duly affirmed we have viewed the ground for said proposed Road and are of the opinion that a Road is necessary we have therefore laid out and do return for Public use the following Road to wit-

Beginning at a post on the Township road in Burnside Township. about Fifty four perches below the Iron Bridge and on line between - Westley Whites land and lot of Reuben Mc-masters Thence by said line about north seventy one & one half degrees west. Twenty one perches to corner of R. McMasters lot. Thence same course along line of E. H. & Westley White Two Hundred & twenty one perches in all. to post corner of said East White & Westley Whites land and on line of John Huffman Thence through Huffmans land north seventy and one half degrees west. thirty two perches to a point. about 20 feet south east of Huffmans Wagon House

Thence South twenty seven degrees west. forty
eight perches to a post on line of John Stuffman &
Washington Gardner's land. Thence through Washⁿ
Gardner's land. South sixty nine degrees west
forty two perches to a post on the line between -
Greenfield and Indiana Counties and on line of

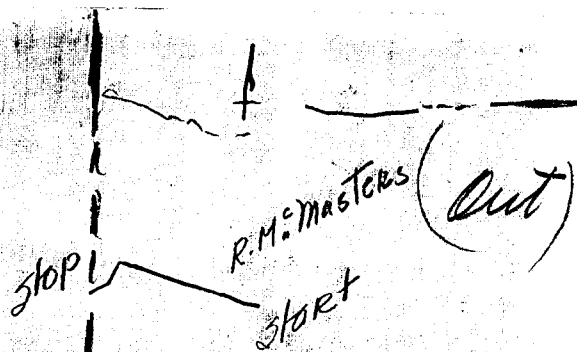
