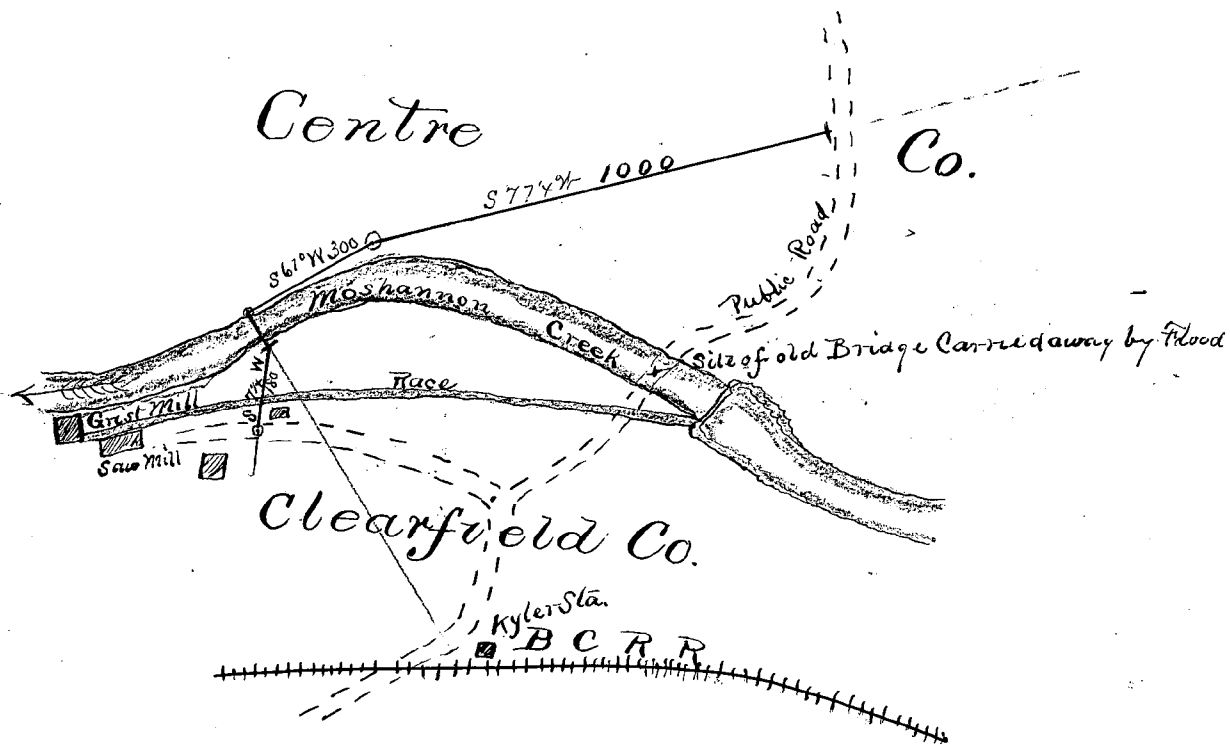
To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County Pa

We the undersigned, ^{two of the} viewers appointed by the annexed
order of Court to view the site for the proposed
bridge within named, respectfully report
that after giving notice of the time and place
of holding said view, we met upon the premises
in pursuance of said notice and having been
severally sworn & affirmed according to law
we viewed the premises and find that a Public
Bridge across Moshannon Creek at the point
within named is necessary and we have located
a site for said bridge as follows Beginning at
a point ^{Near the Stable of J. Kyle} on public Road leading to the Groe Mill
& thence through land now in possession of J. Kyle
South $7\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 180 feet to a Point on the Bank of
Moshannon Creek on the Clearfield Co. side of said
thence across said Creek South $30\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. 79 feet to
a Point on the Clear County side of said Creek (the
last named point being on a large Rock) thence
S 61° West through unimproved land of
- 300 feet & South $7\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 1000 feet
to a Pine Stump on the public Road leading
to Black Moshannon a plot or draft of said
location being hereto annexed, and that the
erecting of said bridge will be attended with
more expense than is reasonable same

Drop ~~the~~ of Cooper should bear but
we the said viewers are of the opinion that
the said township of Cooper should bear
the expense of building the abutment on the
Clearfield side of said Creek. And we recommend
that the bridge be of Iron superstructure of
70 feet span set upon good substantial
Stone Abutments and that the floor of said
Bridge be not less than 15 feet above low
water mark.
