To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of the Peace for Cheapea County

The Petition of the undersigned Inhabitants of
Woodward and Decatur Townships in the said

point at or near Sunborn U.S. Church in
Woodward Township to intersect the old Chea-
pea road at or near Jeffries Post Office in
Decatur Township.

Your petitioners conceive that
portions of the said road is now useless and in-
convenient and that the same should be vaca-
ted and supplied by a road more convenient
to the inhabitants thereof. Your petitioners therefore
pray the Court to appoint proper persons to view
vacate and supply that portion of the said road
from a point at or near the line of Don. Boynton
land to the intersection of said road with the
old Cheapea road and make reports thereon
to Court agreeably to the act of assembly in
such case made and provided.
