As a Court of Quarter
Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield
held at Clearfield in and for said County
on the 6th day of December 1886 before the judges
of the same upon the petition of Sunday
inhabitants of the townships of Jordan^{and}
Ferguson in said County Respectfully representing

That the Existing line between the said
two townships runs directly through the
Villages of Gagsam placing part of the
Village in one Township and part in another
and dividing many of the town lots in
the same way thus causing much con-
fusion and inconvenience in assessments &c

They therefore pray that the line of division
between the townships be changed so as
to conform to the following description:
Beginning at a point on the fourth division
line between the said townships) at the
northerly corner of lands of David Michaels
adjoining lands of W^m Thurston & Charles
Lewis thence North 53 deg East along lands
of David Michaels 130 rods to the

Northwesterly Corner thence South 37 deg East
25 rods to the Westerly Corner of lands of R.
Johnson thence North 53 deg East 128 rods
to the Centre of Little Clearfork Creek to
the mouth of Murrels Run to a point on
the present division line between said
Jordan and Ferguson Thence 42 rods North 52
deg East of Northwesterly Corner of lands of
Joseph Thompson.

And now be it Recd 1886 Petition read and
considered and thereupon the Court
appoints H.D. Bigler Corral Baker and
A.B. Shaw Commissioners who having
been duly sworn to perform their duties
with fidelity and having given due notice
to the inhabitants of said Townships
of Jordan & Ferguson the time and place
of their meeting are to inquire into the
propriety of granting the prayer of the
petitioners and said Commissioners
or any two of them are further directed
to make a plot or draft of said Tracts
of Jordan & Ferguson and the division
line proposed all of which said Com-
missioners or any two of them shall re-
=port at our next bench of Quarter

Sessions together with their opinion of
the same and their opinion of the propriety
of granting the prayer of the petitioner

We the undersigned were appointed
by the foregoing order of Court to view a proposed
change of township line between Jordan and
Perquimans Townships as therein set forth
Respectfully report. That having given due
and public notice of the time and place
of said view in accordance with the Act
of Assembly, we met at the place and time
appointed to wit the 30th August 1887. all
of said views were present, and have all
been severally affirmed we went upon the
ground and examined the proposed change in
Township line, and we report that such
change would be to the convenience and ac-
commodation of both townships, as the present
line runs through almost the center of the town
of Gayram dividing lots and buildings and we
report in favor of a change in the township line
between Perquimans and Jordan Townships as follows

Beginning at a point at the North corner of land
of David Michael adjoining land of Dr. Thurston & others
thence North 53 deg. East 130 perches to Michael
North corner thence South 37 degrees East 25 perches
to western corner of land of R. Thurston thence North 53 deg.
East 120 ps to center Little Choptank Creek thence down
the same to mouth of M. Wells Run thence up said run
to a point on present township line 42 ps North 52
East of North corner of land of Geo. Thompson - a
draft or plot whereof is hereto annexed. Which said
change we report as necessary

To the Honorable the Judges of the
Court of Quarter Sessions of
Clearfield County, Penna

The undersigned Citizens and Tax-payers of said
Clearfield County respectfully present this their petition
for a change, hereinafter described, in a part of the
line dividing the Townships of Oquema and Jordan.

Upon petitioners respectfully represent that the
existing line between the said two townships runs directly
through the village of Orazzam, placing part of the
village in one township and part in another, and dividing
many of the town lots in the same way; thus causing
much confusion and inconvenience in assessments for
purposes of taxation, and in questions relating to Schools.
The proposed line would remove this difficulty, and
would moreover be an improvement of the township line
in other respects.

Upon petitioners therefore pray that the line of division
between the Townships of Oquema and Jordan may be
changed so as to conform to the following description:

Beginning at a point (in the present division line
between the said townships) at the northerly corner of
lands of David Michaels adjoining lands of M^r Thurston
and Charles Lewis; thence North Fifty three degrees East
along lands of David Michaels, One hundred and thirty
(130) rods to his northerly corner; thence South Thirty Seven
degrees East Twenty-five (25) rods to the westerly corner of

Lands of R. Johnson; thence North Fifty three degrees East
 One hundred and twenty-eight rods to the centre of Little
 Clearfield Creek; thence Southeastly up the centre of
 Little Clearfield Creek to the mouth of McKeels Run;
 thence Eastly up the centre of McKeels Run to a point
 (in the present division line between said Indian and
 Ferguson Townships) Fifty-two (42) rods, North Fifty-two
 degrees East of northerly corner of lands of Joseph
 Johnson.

The location of the proposed line and the lands to
 be affected by the change are fully shown in the
 map accompanying this petition
