We the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order of Court to view the premises and assess the damages, if any, which the within petitioner has sustained by reason of the said road, in said order mentioned, respectfully report: That we met for the purpose of performing the duties imposed upon us by said order, at the premises of the petitioner on the 14th day of April, A.D. 1887, and, after having been severally sworn or affirmed, according to law, proceeded to view the premises and assess the damages, as therein directed; and after having carefully viewed the same and taken into consideration the damages sustained by the petitioner by reason of said road passing through his land, as well as also the advantages to be derived from such passage, and the probability of the land reverting to the said petitioner, we are of opinion that he has sustained damages to the amount of Fifteen (\$15.00) dollars, and we do accordingly assess the same at that sum.
