Quarter Sessions of Clearfield Co. Pa

We the undersigned viewers appointed by the Court
to view a site for a public bridge according to
the annexed order of Court, would respectfully
report; that after giving good and sufficient
notice of the time & place of holding said
view, did in pursuance of said notice meet
upon the premises on the 6th day of Sept^r 86.
And after all being first severally sworn or affirmed
according to law. we viewed the premises and find that
a Public Bridge across Clearfield Creek is neces-
sary at the point within named, it being the point
where the Waterford & Erie Turnpike Crosses said
Creek, but the building of such a bridge as is
necessary to accommodate the traveling public would
be of much greater expense than is right that
the townships of ^{Areaber to or} Briggs & Lawrence should
bear. And we have laid out and do return for
public use the following ~~Bridge~~ site for public
use to wit the present site of the old bridge across
the aforesaid Creek And recommend that a single
span Bridge of One hundred and forty (140) Feet
and that the floor of the same be not less
than 18 feet above low water mark

Agree that there is occasion for
such bridge they shall make report
at the next Court of Quarter Sessions
to be held for said County in which
Report they shall state they have
been sworn or affirmed according
to law.
