The petition of the Burgess and Town
Council of Lusair Borough respectfully Represents

That at the time of the incorporation of said Borough
a certain street known in the general plan of said Bor-
ough as Brady Avenue, was laid out and intended
as one of the highways of said Borough and was
intended to be fifty feet wide throughout its entire
length. That a part of said street prior to
the incorporation of said Borough was used as a
public road and was only thirty three feet wide
and at the point leading from north East corner of
J. C. Miller's lot to lot now owned by R. W. Shaw across
curved and of irregular shape.

able Court to appoint seven disinterested free holders
of said Borough to view said street and to
make of the regular width of fifty feet from north
East corner of J. C. Miller's lot to lot of R. W. Shaw

adjoining property owners and they will
