To the Honorable the judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the County of Clearfield.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Township of Covington in said County respectfully, showeth:

That a road has long since been laid out under an order of your Honorable Court (confirmed absolutely on the 28th, day of September, 1883 to No. 13 January Sessions 1882,) from a point on the Frenchville and Fairmont road, and the Lane of Solomon Mourer and James Holt in the South-Easterly direction, and ending at a point on the Big-Basin road, is now become useless, inconvenient and burdensome, and injurious to the farmers through whose land it goes on account of its courses and distances. Your petitioners therefore pray the Court, that the said road may be vacated agreeably to the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided. Your petitioners further set forth that a majority of the original petitioners of the aforesaid road are signed hereto, and that said road has never been opened.
