To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the borough of Chesterhill, in said county and parts adjacent, respectfully represent:-

That a bridge is much needed over the Moshannon Creek at the end of Presqueisle street in the borough of Philipsburg, Centre county, Pennsylvania, where a certain street leading from said borough of Chesterhill now crosses the said Moshannon Creek: that the said Moshannon Creek is the boundary line between the said counties of Centre and Clearfield: That the county of Centre has by proceedings regularly had in the courts thereof agreed and consented to build the half of said bridge as provided by law: That the expense of erecting said bridge, ^{or the half thereof} would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of the said borough of Chesterhill in Clearfield county, Your petitioners, therefore, pray the court to appoint three disinterested men to view the site for said proposed bridge and report the expediency of erecting the half of the same, and to take such action on the subject as is required and directed by the Act of General Assembly in such case made and provided.

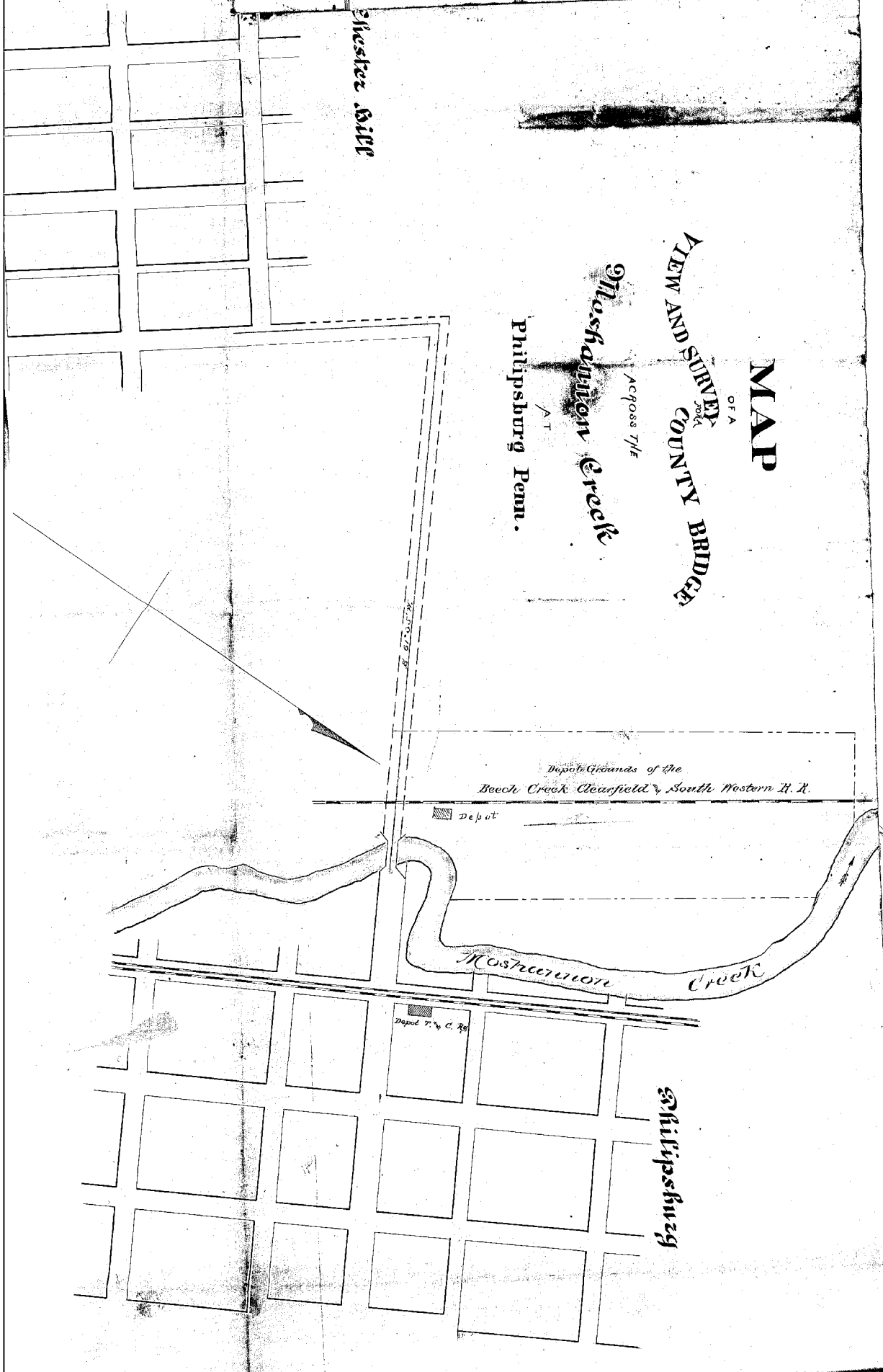

We the undersigned view-
ers appointed by the annexed order of Court - ~~the~~

report: That we met on the 19th day of
April A.D. 1886, the day appointed for
said view, all being present and having
been personally affirmed according to law,
we viewed the premises, and are of the opinion
that a bridge is necessary over Mosheim
Creek at the foot of Piquee Dale Street
in the Borough of Philipsburg in Centre Co.
to connect with Street in the Borough
of Chester Hill in Clearfield County, Pa.,
to the depot of the Buck Creek, Clearfield
and South Western Rail Road Co. - a draft
of proposed location of said bridge being
hereto annexed: and that the erecting of
said bridge would be attended with more
expense than it is reasonable said Borough

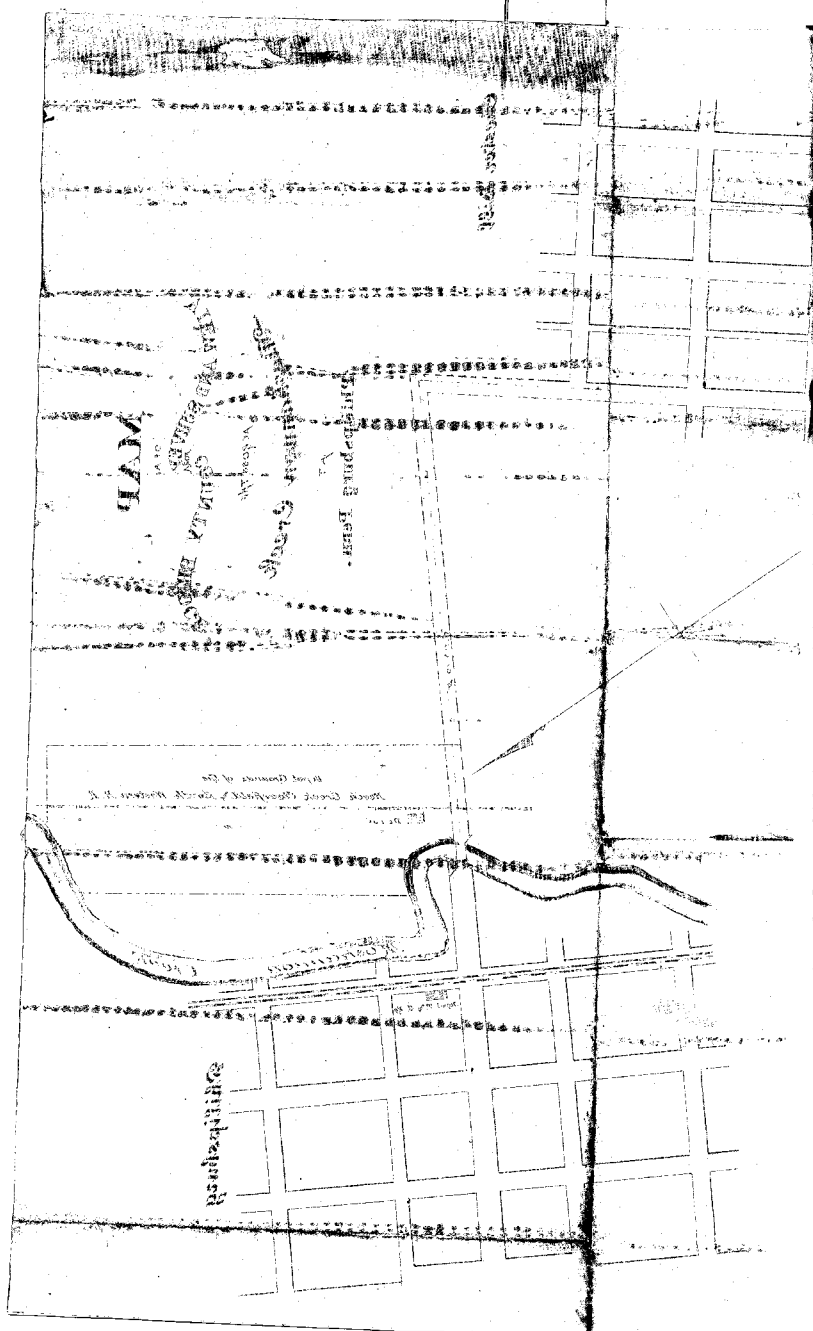

Smith, et al inhabitants of the Borough of Chesterhill in said County and parts adjacent - That a Bridge is much needed over the Moskannon Creek at the end of Presquise Street in the Borough of Philipsburg Centre County Pa, where a certain Street leading from said Borough of Chesterhill now crosses the said Moskannon Creek, that the said Moskannon Creek is the boundary line between the said Counties of Centre and Clearfield - That the County of Centre has by proceedings regularly had in the Courts thereof agreed and consented to build the half of said Bridge as provided by law, That the expense on the half thereof would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of the said Borough of Chesterhill in Clearfield County -

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three disinterested men to view the site for said proposed Bridge and Report the expediency of erecting the half of the same, and to take such action on the subject as is required and directed by the Act of General Assembly in such case made and provided.

Whereupon the Court after due consideration do Order and appoint W D Bigler, W P Wilson and L J Morgan Viewers who after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality to view the proposed

shall make Report at the next Court of Quarter
Sessions to be held for said County, in which
