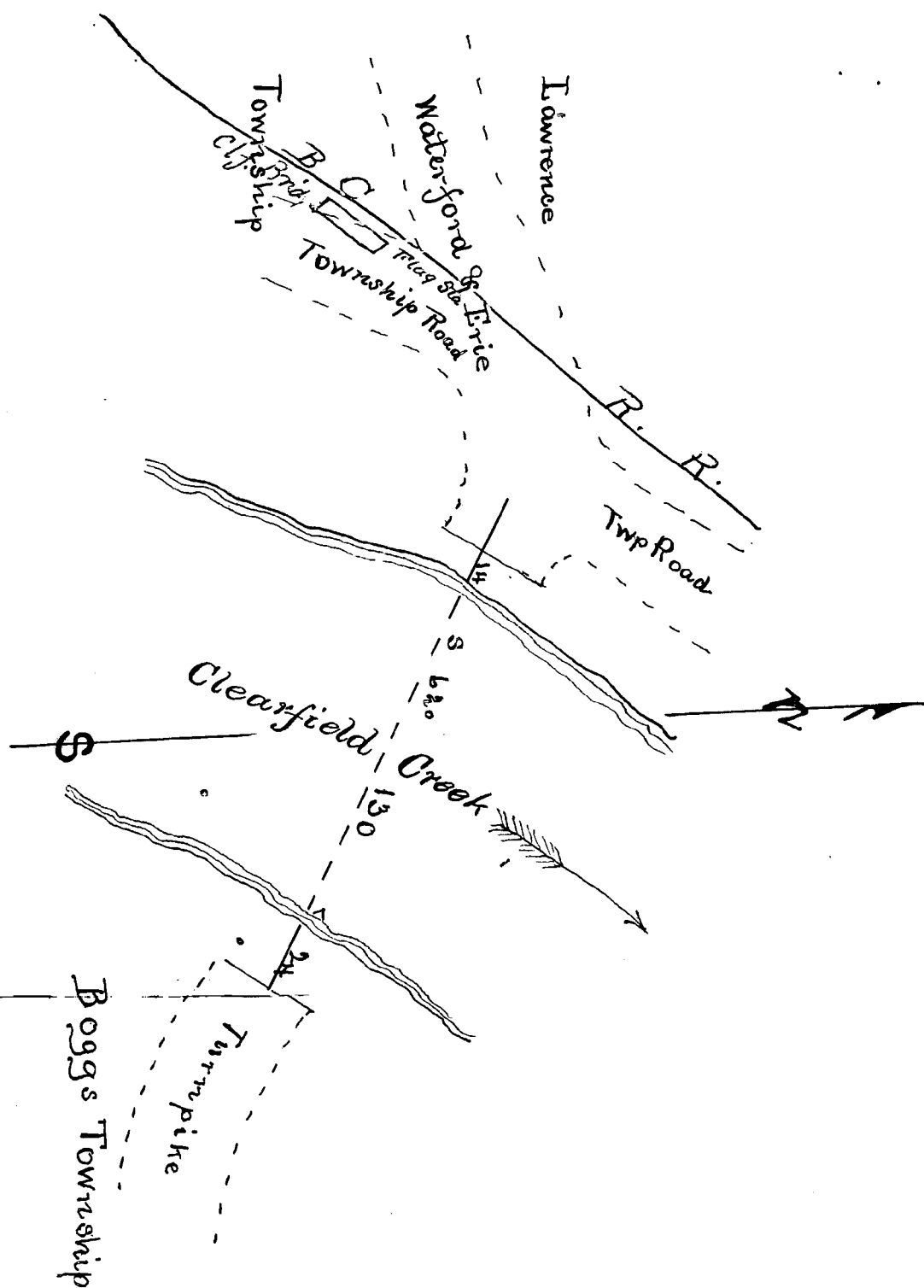

To The Honorable The Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of Clearfield County

We the undersigned viewers appointed to view the Bridge
site named in the annexed order of Court. Respectfully
report.— That in pursuance of said order we
gave public notice of the time & place of meeting
for said view and in pursuance of said notice
we met at the said proposed bridge site on Sat.
the 11th day of Dec Ad. 1886 and after all being present
and severally sworn or affirmed according to law
we viewed the premises within named and find
that a public bridge across Clearfield Creek where
the Erie Turnpike crosses said creek is necessary
and further that the said Bridge if erected would be
of much greater expense than is reasonable that
the said Townships of Boggs & Lawrence should
bear (said creek at this point forming the boundary between
said townships.) We have therefore laid out and do now
return for public use the following bridge site to wit:
The present site of the old bridge across said creek
(long since taken away by flood) and recommend that
a single span bridge of 140 feet be erected and that
the floor of said bridge be not less than 18 feet
above low water mark. a plot or 2 ft being
hereto annexed

itants thereof—

to appoint proper persons to view the premises
and take said such order on the subject as is required
and directed by law—

Whereupon the Court after due consideration
do Order & appoint E. H. Read, H. J. Bigler
& Henry Bridge Viewers, who after being respect-
fully sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of
their appointment with impartiality, to view

the proposed Site for a bridge and Report upon
the necessity whether or not it should be erected
And if any two of them agree that there is occasion
for such bridge they shall make Report at the
Next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said
County, in which Report they shall state whether
they have been sworn according to law
