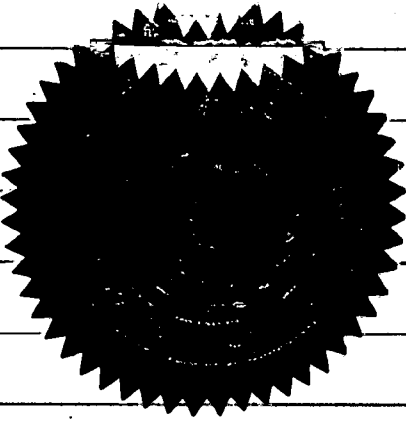

Sessions of the peace in and for the County of
Clearfield held at Clearfield on the 18th Dec
1887 Before the Judges of the same upon the
petition of sundry inhabitants of the Township
of Buarside in said County of Clearfield -
Setting forth that they have under great in-
convenience for want of a new Township by
reason of the size of said Township and that
it will be greatly to their advantage to divide
the said Township in manner following viz:
by a line commencing at a point dividing
the West line Equally thence due East to
intersect line dividing said Township Chest
Township

Whereupon the Court upon due
consideration held of the premises do
order and appoint E. C. Reed & J. F. Ford
and John J. Gallahan as Commissioners or
Viewers who after being duly sworn affirmed
to perform the duties of their appointment
with fidelity and impartiality and to view the
ground proposed for said new Township and
to inquire into the propriety of erecting the
same and make report to the Court as to
the propriety and necessity of same and should

Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County Pa.

We the subscribers viz John F Gallagher Emory C
Read & L J Hurd being the viewers or Com=
missioners appointed by the annexed order of Court
to inquire into the propriety of dividing Burnside twp
in said County and erecting a new Twp out of
a portion of the same respectfully report that
after giving good and sufficient notice ^{of the time & place of meeting for said view} as required
by law we met in pursuance of said notice and all
the viewers appointed being present viz, L. J. Hurd, Jno.
H Gallagher & Emory C Read and after all being
first severally sworn or affirmed according to law
we made such inquiries in the matter as to us seemed
right & proper and after viewing the Territory to be
divided we Jno F Gallagher Emory C Read & L J Hurd

the viewers are of the opinion that to divide
Burnside Twp and erect a new Twp out of a
portion of the same is unnecessary and would be
detrimental to the best interests of the Tax payers
thereof but we ^{and do hereby respectfully recommend} are of the opinion that a division
of said twp into Two Voting Precincts ^{^belonging to} is necessary
and would be a great convenience to the Voters of
said Twp. and we have divided said twp
into two precincts in manner following viz
Beginning at The "Cherry Tree" thence along the Indi=
-ana County line North $3^{\circ}45'$ East 1200 Rods

(or. $3\frac{3}{4}$ miles) to a dead white Pine a corner of
land occupied by Thos. W. Lee thence South
 $86^{\circ}15'$ East 1792 Rods or $5\frac{1}{10}$ miles to a
Hemlock on the line of East Twp. all of that
portion of said twp lying north of the last ~~above~~
mentioned line shall constitute one Precinct and
all that portion ^{of said Twp.} lying south of said line shall
constitute ~~the~~ precinct a plot or draft
of which is hereto attached
