of the Peace of the County of Clearfield
held at Clearfield in ^{the} for said
County on the 11th day of ~~May~~^{June} 1888
before the Judges of the Same Court

Upon the petition of diverse inhabitants of the
Borough of Dubois in said County setting forth
that a bridge is much wanted over Sandy Lick
Creek at the place where the Public highway
leading to A. V. Railroad Station crosses said
Creek in the Borough aforesaid the bridge
at said point now being rotted down ^{and}
unsafe for travel and also a bridge on
said highway across Beaver Run in said
Borough is much wanted as the bridge
across said run is rotted down ^{and} unsafe
for travel ^{and} that the expense of erecting
said bridges would be too heavy ^{and} burthenome
on the inhabitants of said Borough, ^{and}
Therefore pray the Court to appoint
proper persons to view the premises ^{and}
to take such order on the subject as
is required ^{and} directed by the Act of
General Assembly of 16th April 1870

The Court on due Consideration do order
^{and} Appoint Thomas H. Moore Alexander
Shea ^{and} S. J. Burch to view ^{and} report at
the next Term upon the question whether
the expense of erecting the bridges mention-
ed is greater than the Borough of Dubois
should pay alone. Who after being
respectfully sworn or affirmed to perform
the duties of their Appointment with

impartiality & fidelity are to view the places
proposed for said Bridges & if they agree
that there is occasion for such Bridges
& that the erecting of said Bridges would
require more expense than it would
be reasonable the said Borough should
bear they are to make report accord-
ingly & the said Viewers are further au-
thorized to examine the route of the
road Crossing the Creek over which
the said Bridge is prayed for & if in their
opinion a change or variation in the
bed of the road would be an improvement
and saving of expense in the erection of
such a Bridge they are to make report
thereof & cause such Variation as aforesaid
to be accurately surveyed & a map or plot
thereof to be made which shall accompany
said report. The report aforesaid to be
made to the next Court of Quarter Sessions
to be held for the said County of Cleaveland

We the undersigned viewers, appointed by the foregoing order of Court, to view the site for a bridge across Sandy Lick Creek and a bridge across Beaver Run, where the Plank Road crosses said streams in DuBois Borough, do report: That first having given due notice of the time and place of meeting, we all met, and being duly affirmed, we viewed the bridges across said streams, and in our opinion the new bridges are absolutely necessary to vent the waters flowing through the valley of the Sandy Lick, viz: one to be built across said Sandy Lick Creek with a span of one hundred feet: and to be twenty feet wide with a foot bridge on one side at least six feet wide and one across Beaver Run with a span eighty feet long and a drive way twenty feet wide and a foot walk on one side at least six feet wide: that in our opinion the expense of the construction of said bridges would be too great to be borne by the citizens of DuBois Borough and we think, and it is our judgment that the County should assist them in building the same, as exhibited in a draft which we hereto annex.

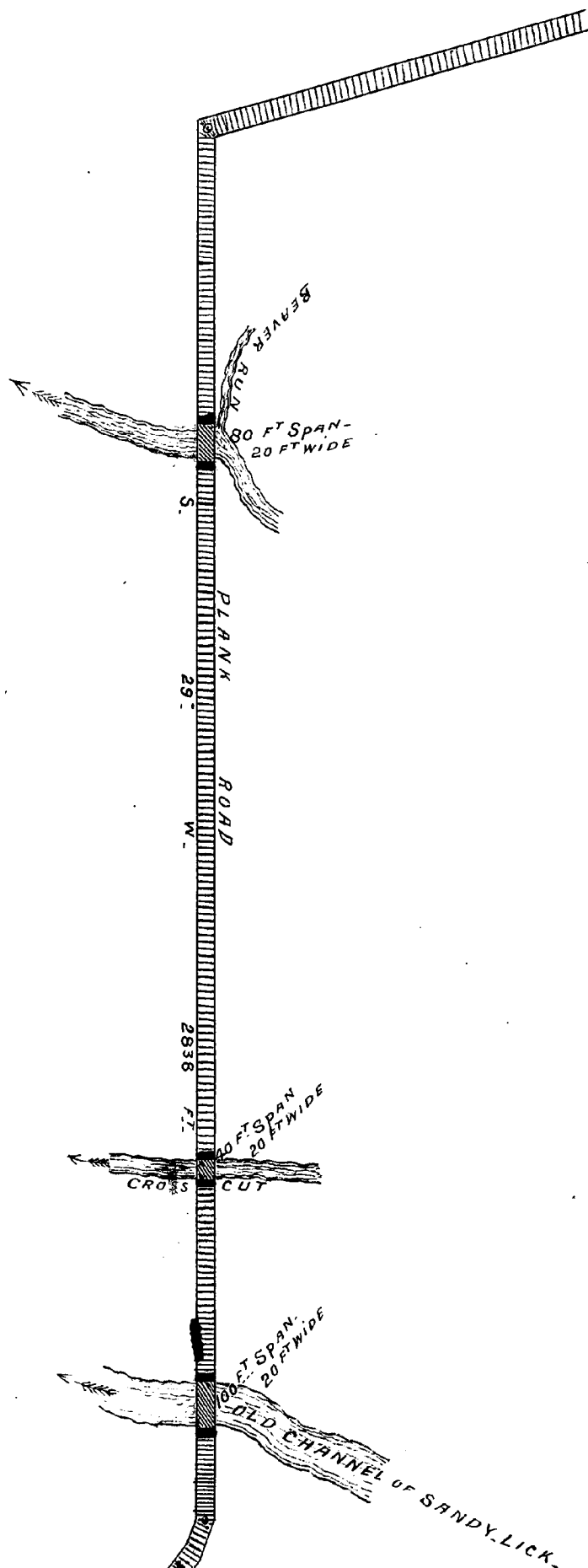
