The Petition of
the Town Council of Dubois
Borough respectfully repre-
sent

That by an ordinance
passed on the 7th day of
Oct. 1889 an alley called High
Street Alley was ordained
laid out and established in
the said Borough the lines
of which were ordained to be
as follows; Beginning at a
point in Weber Avenue in the
line of the lot of James Leavy
38 $\frac{4}{10}$ ft. from the south line
of said lot; thence in a line
parallel with the said ^{South} line
continued till it reaches
Long Street at the corner of
the Jno. S. King lot; thence be-
ginning at the Kirschbaum
& Guthrie corner on Long
Street and extending in a
parallel line with the afore-
said South line of said alley

and at all points - 16 ft. distant
therefrom to Meher Avenue.

That your Petitioners have
been unable to agree with the
owners of the land to be occupied
by said Street for the damages
caused thereto. They therefore
ask that a board of receivers
be appointed according to
law to assess said damages
and they will ever pray.

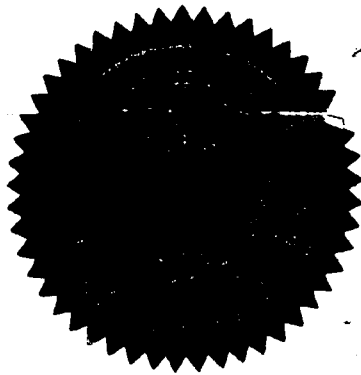

on the 2^d day of December A.D. 1889 Before
Honorable David L. Krebs President Judge
of said Court upon the petition of sundry
Inhabitants ^{Dufford Borough} of the County of Clearfield Penn.
Respectfully represents that an ordinance
passed on the 7th day of Oct 1889 an alley
called High Street alley was ordained
laid out and established in said Borough
the line of which were ordained to be as
follows: Beginning at a point in the corner
in the line of the lot of James L. Leary
38th feet from the south line of said lot. Thence
in a line parallel with the said south line
continued until it reaches Leary Street
at the corner of the John P. King lot. Thence
beginning at the Kirchbaum & Luthmiller Corner
on Leary Street and extending in a parallel
line with the aforesaid south line of said
Alley and at all points 16 feet distance there-
from to West Avenue. T.C.
