Order to View Site Bridge
Clearfield County Pa

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield held at Clearfield in and for the said County On the 3rd day of September A.D. 1889 Before the Judges of our said Court upon the petition of sundry Inhabitants of Boggs & Lawrence Townships in said County Respectfully Represent that they have under great inconvenience for want of a Public Bridge. That the bridge across Clearfield Creek known as the City Bridge between Boggs & Lawrence Townships has been washed away by the floods causing serious inconvenience to Travelers. That said bridge was originally erected under the act of the General Assembly of Penna. of 16th April A.D. 1870. That it is actually necessary to replace said Bridge as soon as possible and that the subscribers have elected a Committee to take charge of said work. That your petitioners would therefore pray your Honorable Court to appoint Viewers to report on said Bridge to be built under act of General Assembly of 16 April 1870. Whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises do order and appoint D. J. McCloskey, D. W. Moore and W. J. Hoffer Viewers who are to view the proposed site and make report at December Sessions 1889 and in which report they are to state whether they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
