said County on the 2nd Sept 1889 Before Honorable
David L Krebs Presiding Judge of said County upon
the petition of sundry Inhabitants of the Counties
of Clearfield and Centre. Respectfully represents —
That a bridge is much wanted over Monahannon
Creek being the line of said Counties at the place
where the public road or highway to Philipsburg
crosses the said Creek in the Township of Decatur
in Clearfield County and in the township of Rush
in Centre County and that the Erection of such
bridge will require more Expense than it is reason-
-able the said Townships should bear. Your petitioners
therefore pray the Court to appoint proper persons
to view the premises and take such order on the
subject as is required and directed by the acts
of Assembly in such case made & provided —
And now 2nd Sept 1889 Petition read & considered
and thereupon Harry Byers D. W. Moore & W. J. Hoffman
are appointed Viewers who are to meet three persons
appointed by the Quarter Session's Court of Centre
County at the place proposed for the bridge as
written specified and having viewed the premises
to make report at December Session 1889 and
in which report they are to state whether they
were sworn or affirmed according to law

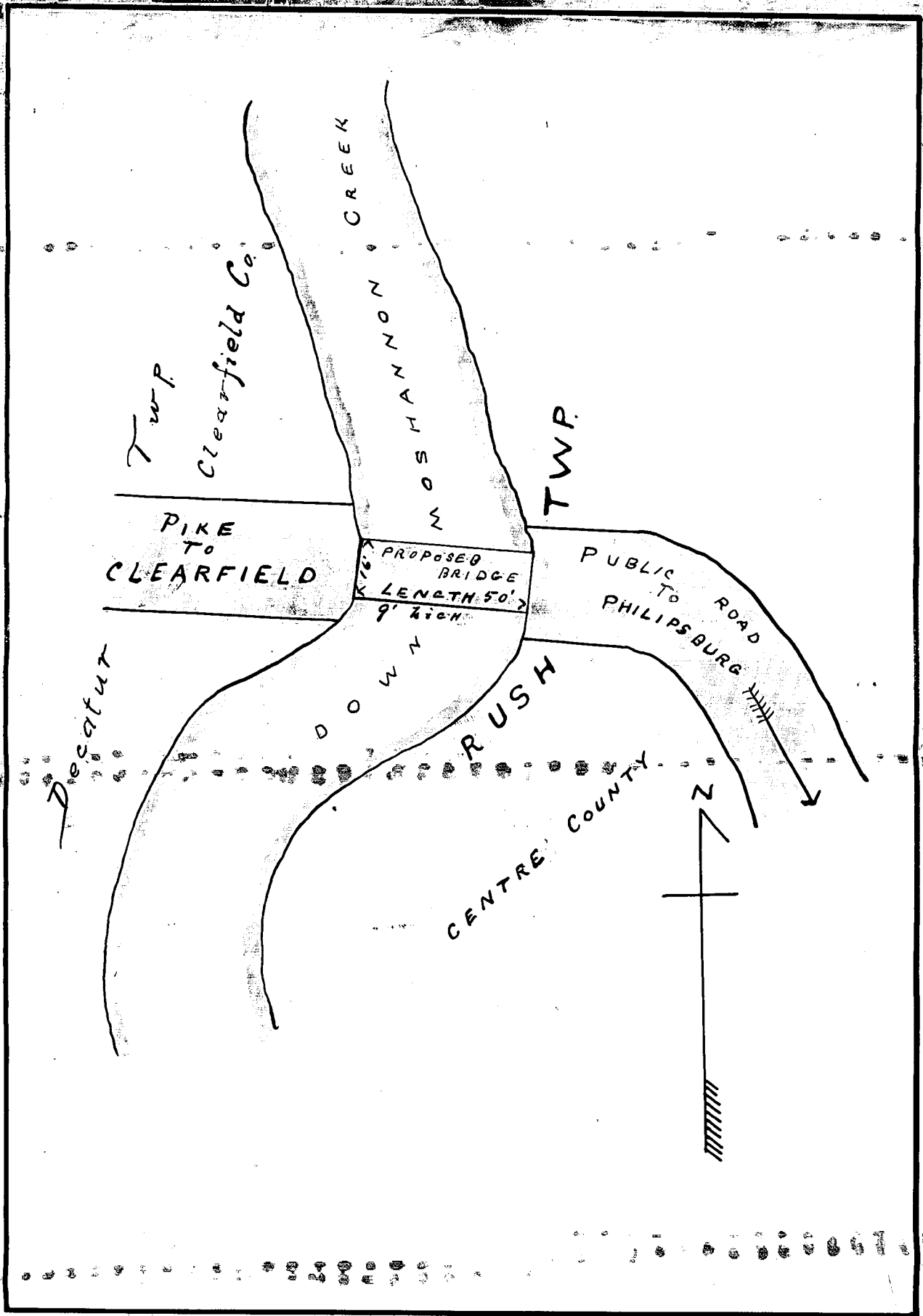

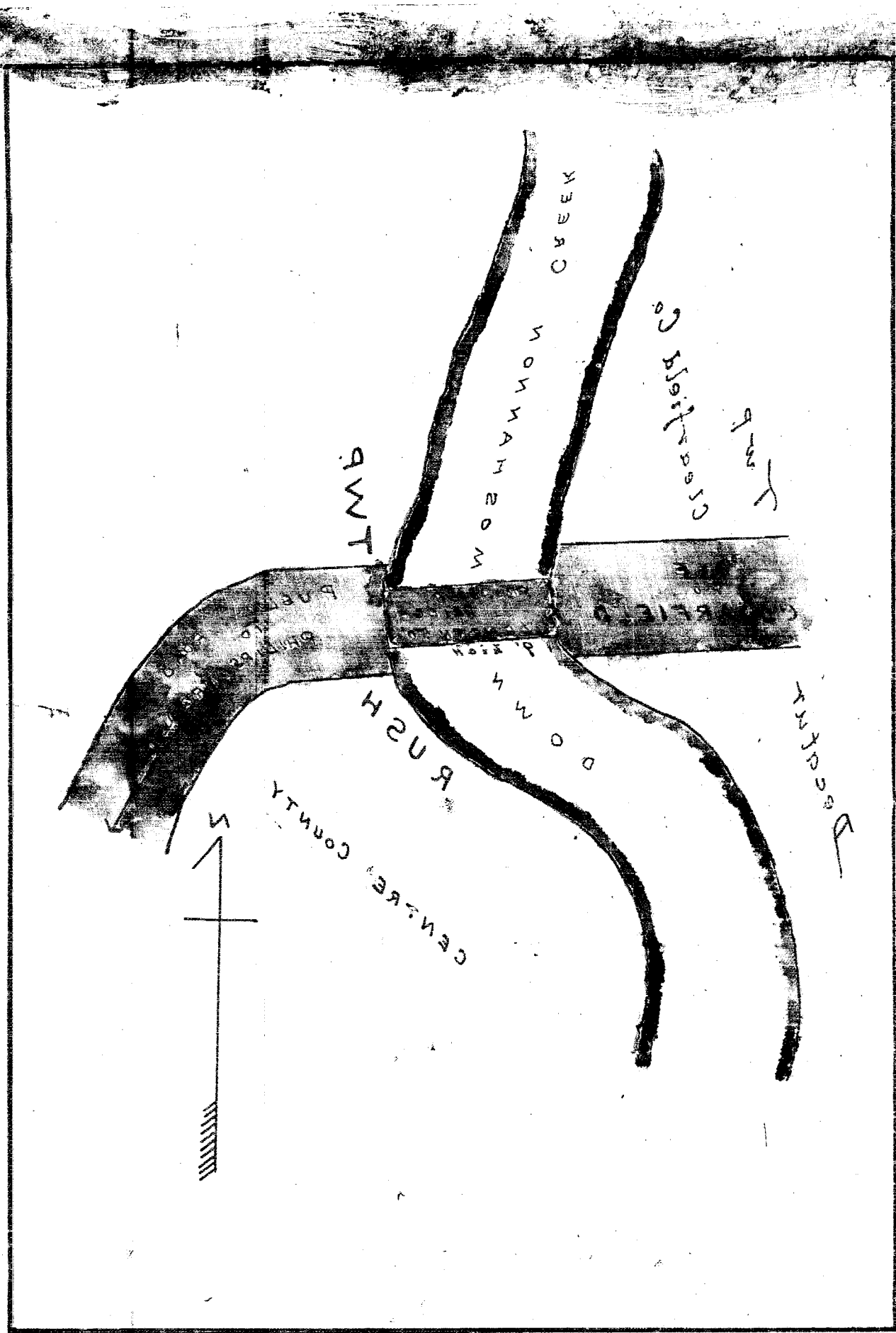
To the Hon. David L. Krebs, within named.

We, the subscribers appointed by the within order of court and a similar order of the Court of Quartersession of Centre County to view the place proposed for the bridge in the within order mentioned respectfully report: that, having present, together with Jesse Cleaver, Samuel Billiland and Constance Curtin, also appointed as aforesaid, and having given due notice of time and place of meeting, and having all been first severally sworn or affirmed according to law, we have viewed the premises and are of opinion that a bridge over Moshannon Creek at the place where the public road to Philipsburg in Decatur Township crosses said Creek is necessary, and that the erecting of such bridge would be attended with more expense than it is reasonable the said township should bear. We would recommend a substantial bridge of fifty feet span in the clear, sixteen feet roadway in the clear and nine feet in the clear above low water mark.
