County.

showeth, that a bridge is much wanted
over Bleasfield Creek at the place where
the Old One Lump Pike formerly crossed
said creek, said pike having long since
been taken and made a township road,

bridge would be too expensive and
burdensome to said two townships or to
the inhabitants thereof.

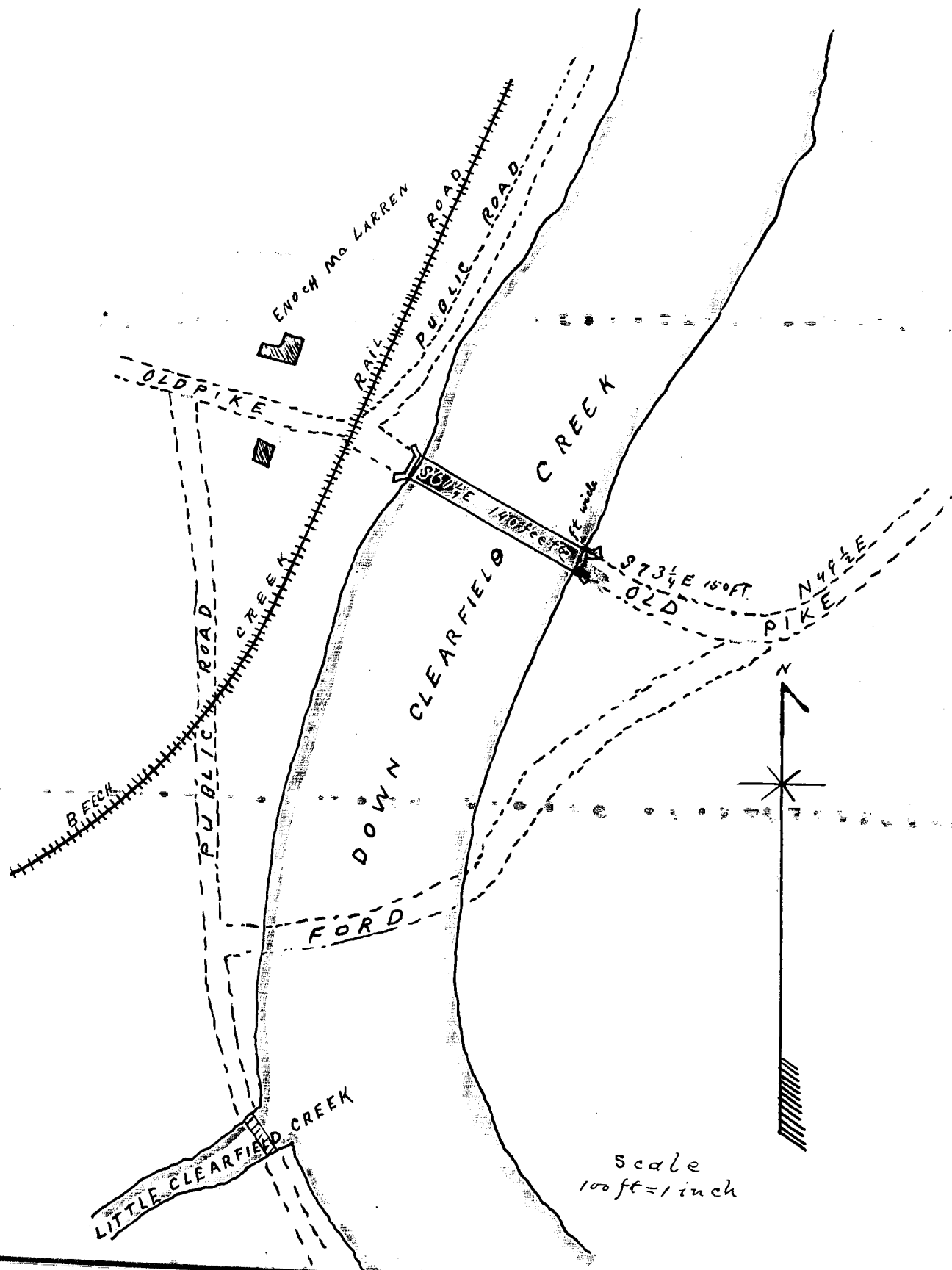

To, The honorable David L. Kriebz Pres-
ident Judge of the court of Quartersessions
of Clearfield County, we the undersigned
viewers appointed by the within order of
court to view the place proposed for a
bridge as within mentioned respectfully
report: that we gave public notice of said
view as required by law and all being pres-
ent at the view and having all been first
severally sworn or affirmed, we have viewed
the premises afore said and are of opinion that
a bridge over Clearfield Creek where the Erie
Turnpike formerly crossed it is necessary
and that the erecting of such a bridge would
be attended with more expense than it is
reasonable that the said Townships should
bear and therefore we would recommend that
the County appropriate sufficient amount
of money to put the bridge on the ~~the~~ abutments
and that the respective townships build the abut-
ments and fill the approaches. we further
recommend that the bridge be a single span
of one hundred forty feet eighteen feet wide and
seventeen feet above low water marks. We be-
lieve the location of the former bridge is the
best and least expensive and therefore no
change in the road bed is necessary.
