reasonable the said townships should bear; your petitioners, there-
fore, pray the Court to appoint proper persons to view ~~map~~ the
premises, and take such order on the subject as is required and di-
rected by the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided.

after viewing the premises the said Commissioners
make report at December 1st 1889 and on
which report they shall state whether they
have been duly seen or affirmed according
to law.

by the within order of court and

the place proposed for the bridge
in the within order mentioned,

Respectfully report: that, having
been present, together with Jesse
Cleaver, Samuel Billiland and Con-
stance Curtin, also appointed as afo-
reaid, and having given due notice
of time and place of meeting, and
having all been first severally sworn
or affirmed according to law we
have viewed the premises, and
are of opinion that a bridge over
Moshannon Creek where the Public
Highway to Philipsburg in Morris Town-
ship crosses said creek is necessary
but there is a bridge there now which
answers every purpose and will last
for several years so that we would
not recommend the construction of a
new bridge at the present time.
