To the Honorable, the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of the County of Clearfield, Pa.:

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Borough
of Curwensville, in said County, respectfully represents:

That a bridge is necessary over Anderson Creek in said
borough of Curwensville at a point where the public road
or highway leading from Curwensville to Burnside and Penn-
ville is crossed by said creek; and that the erecting of the
said bridge requires more expense than it is reasonable that
the inhabitants of said borough should bear; that viewers
were duly appointed by your Honorable Court to view the said
proposed site for bridge, and said viewers reported that
said bridge was necessary and said Report was duly approved
by the Grand Jury and by the Court at September Term, 1890,
and County Commissioners have agreed to assist building the
same; that said viewers recommended a change in the road and
site of the bridge so as to locate it at the foot of Walnut
street, in said borough; that to build the bridge at the
foot of Walnut street would be very expensive, and would
entail more expense than the old location of the bridge.
Your petitioners therefore pray that the bridge may be lo-
cated at the old location.

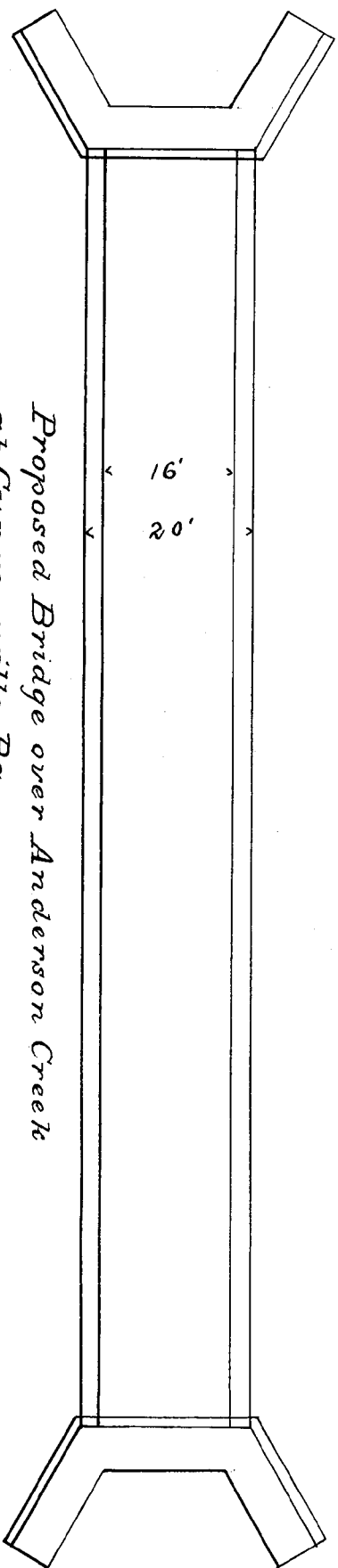
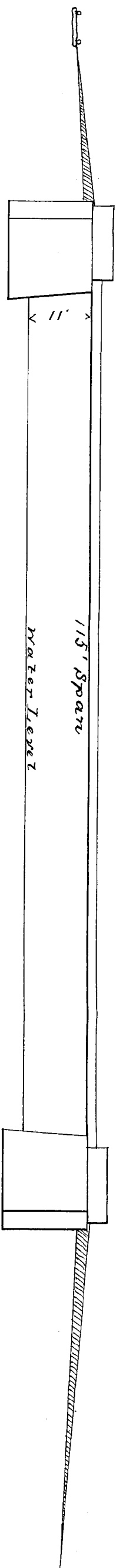
