At a Court of Quarter Session
of the Peace of the County of Clearfield held at Clear-
field Pa in and for said County on the 1st day
of July 1879 Before Hon D C Kress President
Judge upon the petition of sundry inhabitants
of the Borough of Clearfield in said County Repre-
senting that during the high flood the bridge
crossing Anderson Creek in the Borough of Clearfield
on the road leading from ~~Campbell's~~ to ~~Clearfield~~
was swept away and that they suffer great
enormous loss of work of said bridge, and that
the expense of erecting said bridge would be
too heavy & burdensome upon the inhabitants
of said Borough. Your petition therefore prays
Your Honor to appoint proper persons to view
the premises and take such order on the
subject as is required and directed by act of
Assembly in such case made & provided.

Whereupon the Court upon due Consideration
had of the premises do order and appoint Mr.
Welles J. McCreary and Enos Bloom Vassors
who are to have the same and make report
at Sept 5 1889 held at Cleveland on the
first Monday of Sept 1889 which report they
shall state whether they have been sum
according to law) By the Court

Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.


We the subscribers, persons appointed
by the Court to view the place
proposed for the bridge over Anderson
Creek in the Borough of Curwensville
respectfully report that all being
present on the 15th day of July A.D. 1809
at the view of the place proposed
for the bridge in the attached
order mentioned, & having all been
first solemnly sworn or affirmed, in
pursuance of said order we have
viewed the premises aforesaid,
and are of the opinion that a
bridge over Anderson Creek at
the place where the public
highway from Curwensville to
Burnside crossed said Creek in
the Borough of Curwensville is
necessary, and that the erection of
such bridge would be attended
with more expense than it is
reasonable said Borough should
bear, and we further report
that after proper examination
we are of the opinion that a
change in the bed and route of
said road would be an improvement
and a saving of danger and
expense by bridges being again
washed away, and also remove
danger of loss of life by the

present grade crossing over the
Tyone and Clearfield rail-road;
and therefore further report that
the route of the road should
be changed so that the bridge
should be put at the foot of
Walnut Street in said Borough,
said change being particularly
set forth in the draft hereto annexed.
beginning at center of Walnut St on ^{south} lower
side of Meadow St turner 108-45' to
315 feet, turner 570-30' to end of old
bridge.


