The petition of the undersigned
residents of Girard Township is in-
debted on the road fund to the amount
of Six thousand six hundred & eighteen $\frac{22}{100}$

Dollars as is shown by the statement
of the Township Auditors hereto attached.

That said indebtedness is due to
different parties other than a former
Supervisor or Overseer of the Poor and
exceeds the amount which the Supervi-
sors may collect in any year. That in
order to pay said debt it is necessary
to lay or levy Twelve Mills on the as-
sessed valuation which aggregates
on the Seated property as shown by Cer-
tificate of County Commissioners hereto
attached. They therefore pray that an
order in the nature of a Mandamus
may issue directing the Supervisors to
collect by special taxation sufficient
to cover said indebtedness.

Your petitioners
further represent in their judgment
the amount of said indebtedness is
so large as to render it inadvisable
to collect the same in any one year tak-
ing into consideration other necessary

taxation. They therefore suggest - that
the same be levied and collected in
three annual installments of four
mills each. Your petitioners further pray
that your honorable Court - further decree
that all moneys so raised be applied
to the payment of the indebtedness created
prior to this order exclusively and no
portion thereof to any order issued as
debt - contracted subsequently until
all such prior indebtedness is fully
paid. This application is made in
accordance with the provisions of the
first section of the act of 31st of March
1864 Purdon 1368

And now Jan'y 14th 1889. within petition read &
considered and it is hereby ordered and decreed that
the Supervisors of Girard township levy a cash tax of
twelve mills on the dollar of assessable property ac-
cording to the present assessed valuation and that the
said cash be levied as follows to wit: four mills for 1888,
four mills for 1889. and four mills for 1890. and
that all money raised by said cash tax be ap-
plied to payment of the said indebtedness, and that no
portion of it be applied to any other purpose or the pay-
ment of any order issued or debt contracted after the
date of this order until all former indebtedness is paid.
