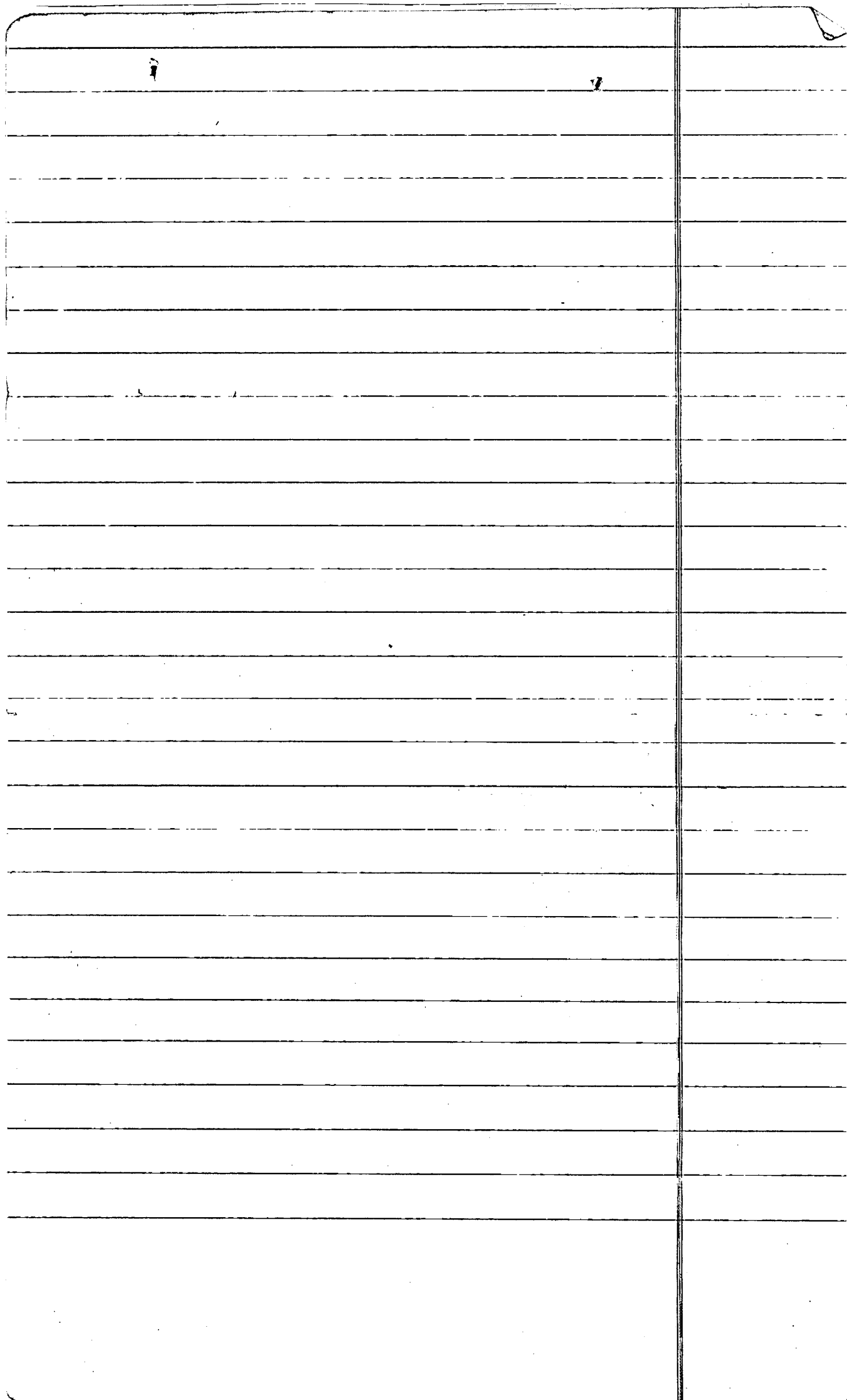

We the undersigned Viewers appointed
by the within Order of Court, to view the
Site for a public Bridge across the Susquehanna
River at the Village of Belleville, in Greenwood
Township. Respectfully report. That having given
notice of the time, and place of meeting, accor-
ding to the act of assembly, and being all present
at the view of the site proposed for the said
Bridge, and being all sworn, or affirmed - in
pursuance of the said Order of Court. We have
performed the duties of our appointment, and find
that in our Opinion a public Bridge is necessary
at that point. And we also find that it will require
a single span, one hundred and ninety five (195)
feet in length, and twenty one (21) feet high above
low water mark. And further we are of opinion that
the expense of erecting said Bridge will be too
great for the said Township of Greenwood to
bear.
