President Judge of the Court of Quarter-
Sessions of Clearfield County Pa, we
The Undersigned viewers appointed by
the within order of court to view and
layout the road therein mentioned
respectfully report; That we gave
good and lawful notice of said road-
view and met agreeable thereto on
Nov. 13, 1890 and having been sever-
ally sworn or affirmed we have viewed
and laid out and do return for public
use the following road to wit; begin-
