1 To the Honorable Judge of the Court of Quar-
2 ter Sessions of Blairfield County

3 We the undersigned Viewers
4 appointed by the foregoing Order of Court
5 for the purposes therein set forth do Report
6 that after having given due notice of the
7 time and place of meeting we all met
8 and having been duly sworn and affirmed
9 according to Law we have examined - the
10 condition of said Bridge which crosses Falls
11 Creek near the A.V. Rail Road and find that
12 it is in a very unsafe condition and must
13 be immediately rebuilt - and that it is on a
14 well travelled Public road leading from Du-
15 Bois to the Beechwoods and Reynoldsville.
16 And further that we are of the opinion that
17 the expense of rebuilding said Bridge would
18 be greater than said township of Sandy could
19 reasonably bear and would recommend that
20 said township should build the necessary
21 abutments and approaches for the same and
22 that the County furnish the Iron or make
23 an appropriation equivalent thereto. The length
24 of span required would be 80 or 90 feet - all of
25 which we respectfully submit.
