of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

The petition of the undersigned
inhabitants and citizens of the Borough
of Pennville and vicinity in said county

Respectfully sheweth: That a
bridge is badly needed over little Au-
derson Creek in said Borough on
the public highway leading from Penn-
ville to Curwensville, Lewisburg City &c.
the bridge at that point having
gone away. That a permanent
bridge with substantial abutments
is needed at that point.

That the site of said bridge is
wholly within the territorial limits
of Pennville Borough and that the
expense of erecting such a bridge
as is required is too expensive
for the district to bear.

Your petitioners therefore pray
your Honorable Court to appoint
proper persons to view the premises
and report the facts together with
their recommendation to your Honorable
Court. In order that your Honorable
Court and the Grand Jury may
consider whether such bridge is

necessary and may recommend
 an appropriation by the County
 Clearfield to aid in the construction
 of bridges, in accordance with
 the provisions of the Act of Assembly
 of June 11th 1879.
 And they will certify.

We the undersigned viewers appointed
by the within order of court to view
the site for a public bridge across
a branch of Little Anderson Creek
in the Borough of Pennville,

Respectfully report that having given
notice of the time and place of meeting
according to the act of assembly, and
bring all present at the view of the
site proposed, and bring all sworn or
affirmed in pursuance of said order
of court that we have performed the
duties of our appointment, and find
that in our opinion a public bridge
is necessary at that point, and find
that a span of ~~at~~ thirty (30) would
be amply sufficient, but the stream
and span being so small it would be
establishing a bad precedent for the
county to bear the expense of erecting
a bridge of that size, and we further
do not consider it would be burdensome
on the Borough to bear the expense of
its erection.
