Whereas, by virtue of proceedings brought to the above term and number after report thereupon made by viewers duly appointed, and the approval thereof by the Grand Jury of Clearfield County and by the Court, a public bridge across Clearfield Creek at Driftwood Fording was recommended by the proper authorities, and whereas after such recommendation and approval, a public bridge across Clearfield Creek was built at an expense of \$6840.00, which was paid by Clearfield County; and whereas the said bridge has never been entered upon the records of Clearfield County as a county bridge, and whereas by petition presented by a large number of taxables and inhabitants of Boggs, Woodward and Knox Townships duly familiar with the facts, as well as by knowledge of the situation possessed by the County Commissioners themselves, it appears that the care, maintainance, and responsibility of said bridge are greater than it is reasonable that the townships of Boggs and Woodward or either or both of them should bear.

NOW, therefore, be it resolved this 8th day of February, 1910, that the said Driftwood Fording Bridge be entered upon the records as a county bridge with all the incidents thereunto appertaining the same as if said bridge

had been originally constructed as a county bridge instead of contribution bridge; this action, however, to be subject to the approval of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.
