reason of ice and high waters and
there being a Rail Road now constructed
along said river and the expence
of erecting said Bridge would be too
heavy and burthensome upon the
inhabitants of said township

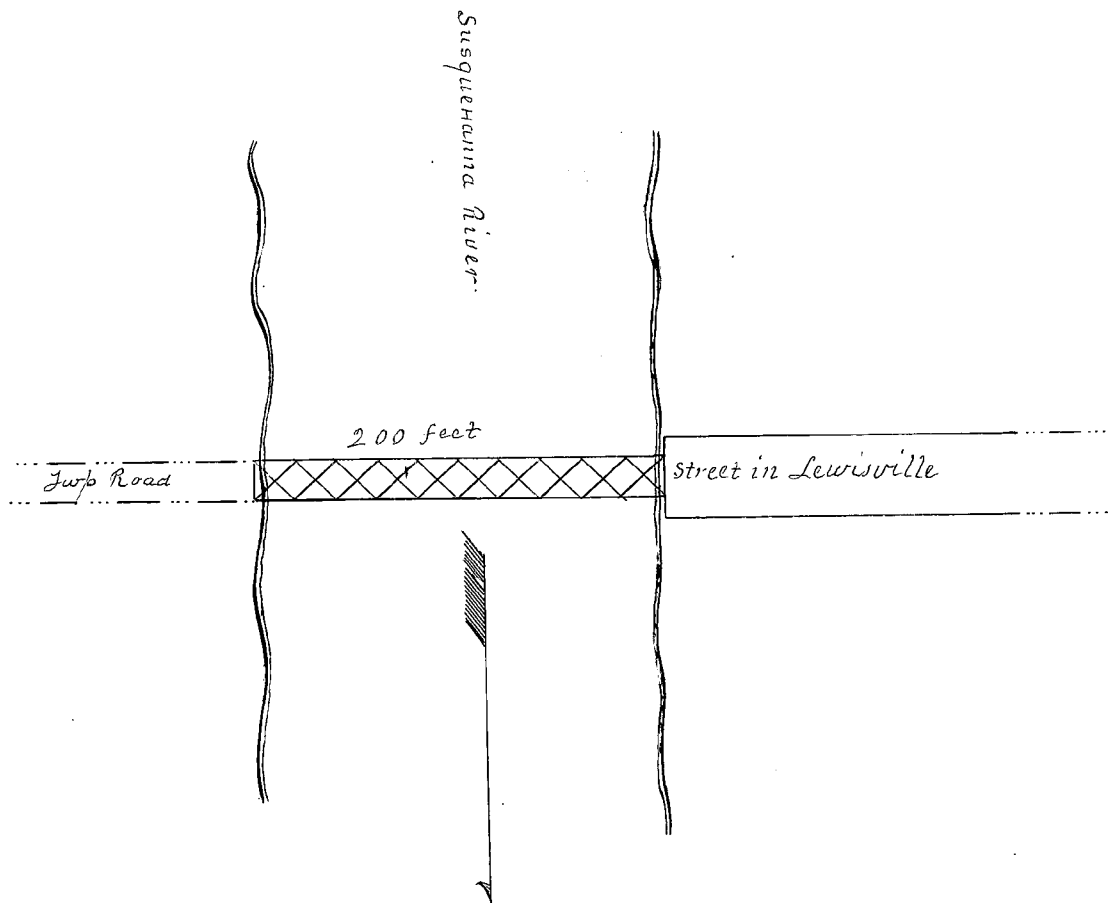

To the Hon Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County.

We the undersigned persons ap-
pointed by the within Order of Court
to view the site for a Bridge at Lewisville
in Greenwood Township. As therein mentioned
respectfully report.

That having given notice of the
time, and place of meeting according
to the Act of Assembly, and being all present
at the view of the ground. or site proposed
for the said Bridge, and being all-
sworn or Affirmed, in pursuance of the
said Order of Court. we have viewed the
site proposed for the said Bridge, and
believing that a Bridge at that Point would
be necessary, and convenient for public use.
We find that it would require a span of
two hundred, and twenty (220) feet. in
length, and to be eighteen (18) feet high
above low water mark. And we are of
opinion that the Cost of erecting said Bridge
would be too great for the Township of
Greenwood to bear. A plan or draft
of which is hereunto annexed
