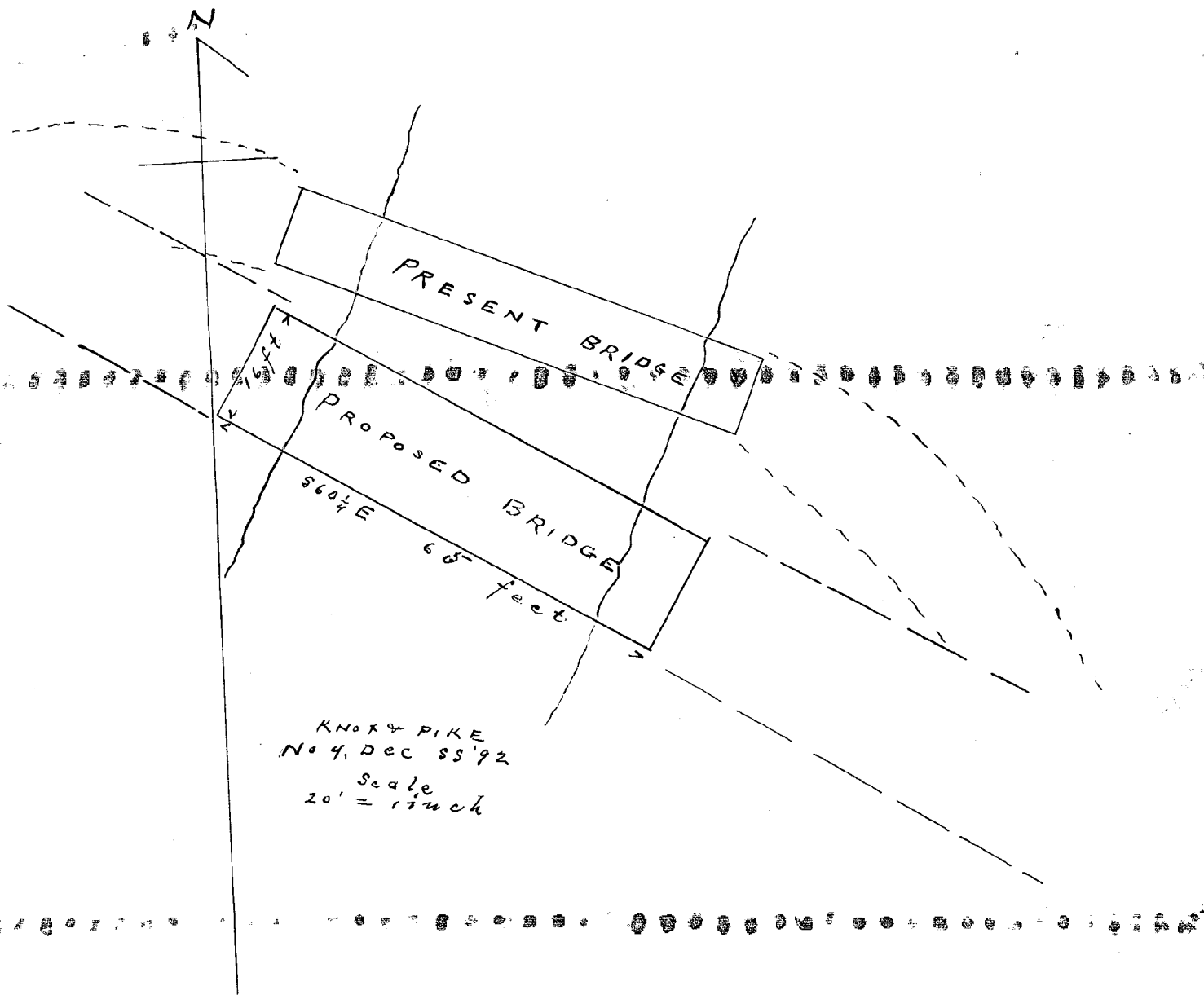

of said County upon the Petition of the Inhabitants
of Know and Pike Townships County of Clearfield
Respectfully represents: That a Bridge is much
wanted over "Little Clearfield Creek" being the line
of said Townships at the place where the Public
Highway leading from Houtzdale to Conowingo
Crosses the said "Little Clearfield Creek" on the line
between the said Townships of Pike and Know at
the Village of Olanta in said County and that
the Expense of Erecting said Bridge would be
too burdensome upon the inhabitants of said
Townships of Pike and Know and that proper
Persons be appointed to View the premises
and to take such order on the subject as is
required and directed by law, &c.

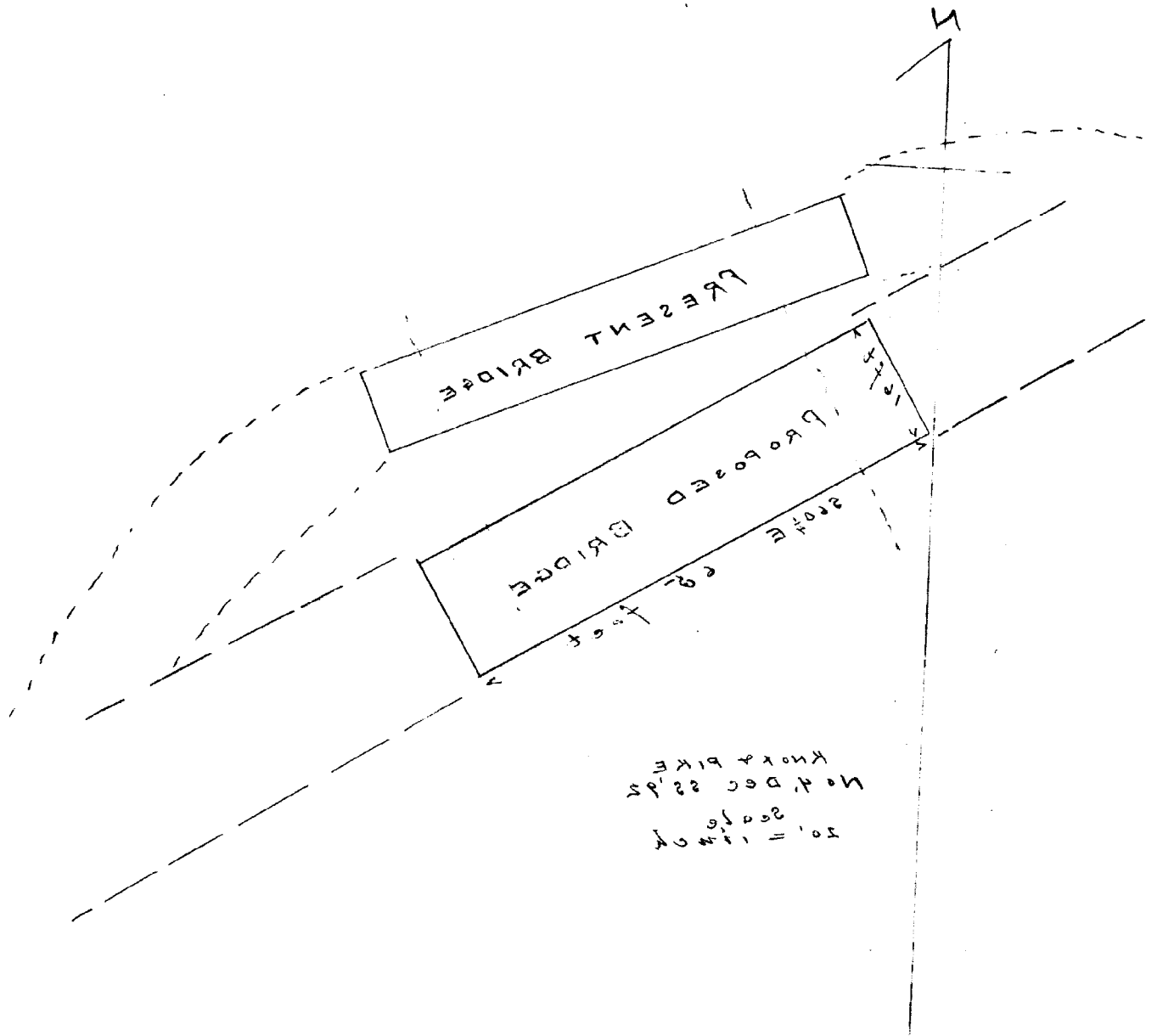
And now December 8th 1872 Petition presented

To The Honorable David L. Krebs President
Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions
of Clearfield County Pennsylvania, we
The undersigned viewers appointed by the
within order of court to view and report
on the bridge therein mentioned respectfully
report: That we gave good and lawful
notice of said bridge view, and were
all present at a view and having been
severally sworn or affirmed we have
viewed ground for the proposed bridge and
are of opinion that it is necessary
for public use and that the erection
thereof would be attended with greater expense
than it is reasonable the two townships
should bear, and we therefore recommend
that the County build the superstructure
(the respective townships building the abutments)
We further recommend that the bridge be
placed below present structure as shown
on plan and township road be made to
lead to it as it would then be avoiding two
turns in road, that it be sixty five foot span in
the clear, one foot higher than the present structure
is at West end, and with sixteen foot roadway. Witness our
