Public Bridge

Contents:

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To the Honorable the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County,

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township of Union, in the said County respectfully sheweth, that a new bridge is much wanted over Anderson Creek, at the place where the public highway leading from Rockton to Clearfield, in said Township, the old bridge across said stream at that place being out of repair and dangerous to cross; and that the expense of erecting said bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of said Township. Your petitioners therefore pray your Honor to appoint proper persons to view the premises, and to make such order on the subject as is required and directed by the Act of General Assembly in such case made and provided and that your Honor, after the return of the view thereon with the County Commissioners, before submitting the matter to the Grand Jury, of said County, fix and ascertain the sum necessary to be appropriated out of the Treasury of said County toward the erection of said bridge, as required and directed by the Act of Assembly of the 6th. of April 1870 entitled an "Act in reference to Bridges in the County of Clearfield" &c.

We, the undersigned Persons
Appointed by the within Order of
Court, to view the site for a Bridge
across Anderson Creek, as therein men-
tioned, Respectfully report:-

That having given notice of the
time, and place of Meeting, according
to the act of assembly, and being all-
present at the view of the site proposed
for the said Bridge. And being all
sworn or affirmed, in pursuance of the
said Order. We have attended to the
duties of our appointment. and find
that a Bridge at that point is necessa-
ry. The one now in use being in bad con-
dition and dangerous for Teams to cross-
and we also find that the expense of erec-
ting such Bridge as ought to be built at
that point, would be too great for the inhab-
itants of the said Township of Union to
bear. and we recommend that the said
County of Clearfield make such appro-
priation, as would be necessary to assist
the said Township of Union in erecting
the said Bridge

Said Bridge will require a single beam
One hundred and five (105) feet in length.
and Seventeen feet (17) clear above low.
water mark.

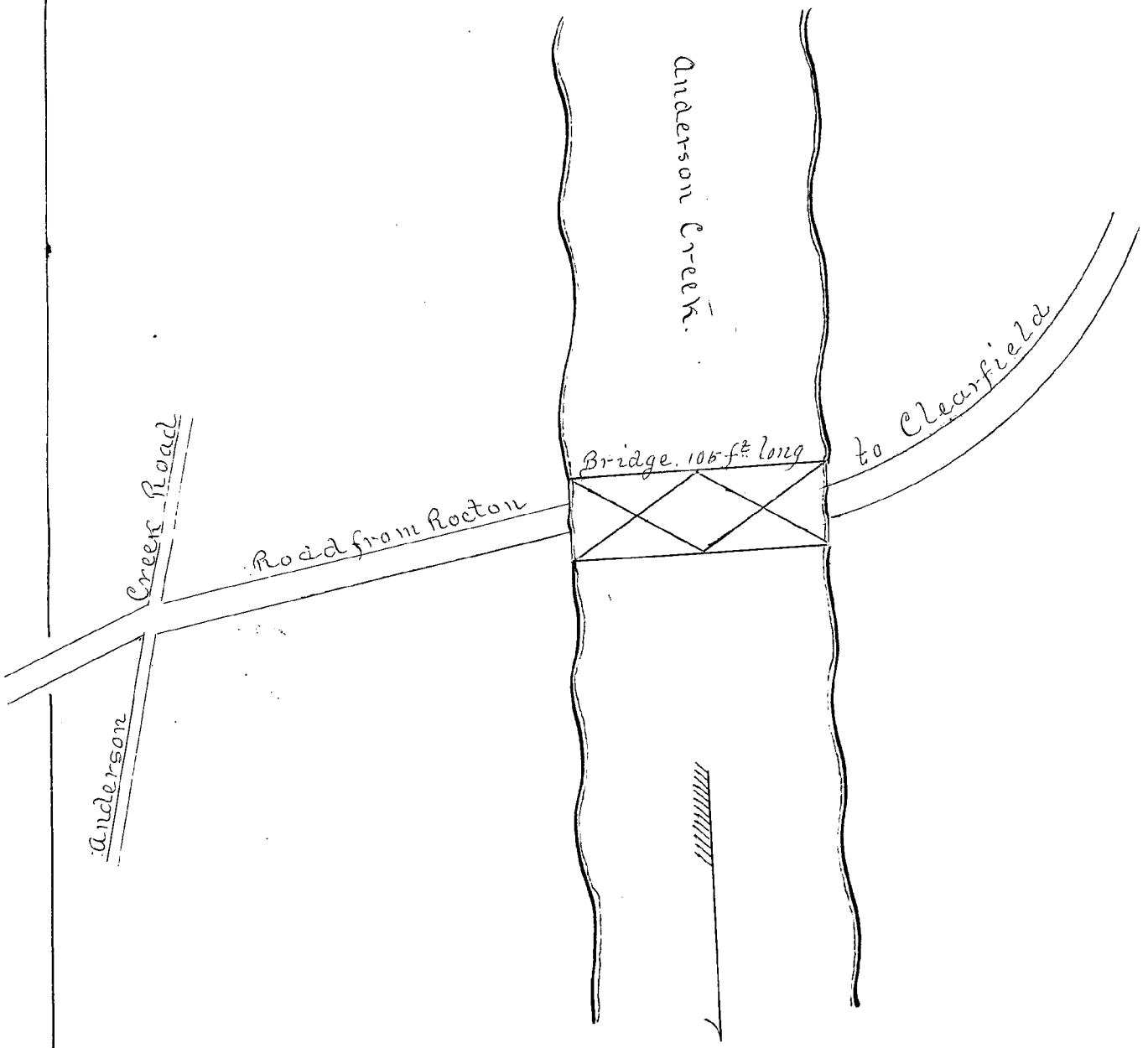
