ship aforesaid; the crossing there being frequently rendered im-
passable by the bridge which is a wooden structure being swept
away by the ice and high water; and that the expense of erecting
said Iron bridge would be too heavy and burthensome upon the in-
habitants of said township.

proper persons to view the premises and to make such order on
the subject as is required and directed by the Act of the Gener-
al Assembly in such case made and provided.
