At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the Fourth day of September, A. D. 1893, before Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Bigler, in said County, setting forth that

That that portion of the Public Turnp road leading from Banion to Madera Beginning at a point at the line of J. H. Shoff on said road to a point where said road intersects a road leading from Houtzdale to Glen Hope has become useless dangerous and burdensome to the Citizens of the Turnp

That a new safer and better road could be laid out to supply the place of the old road

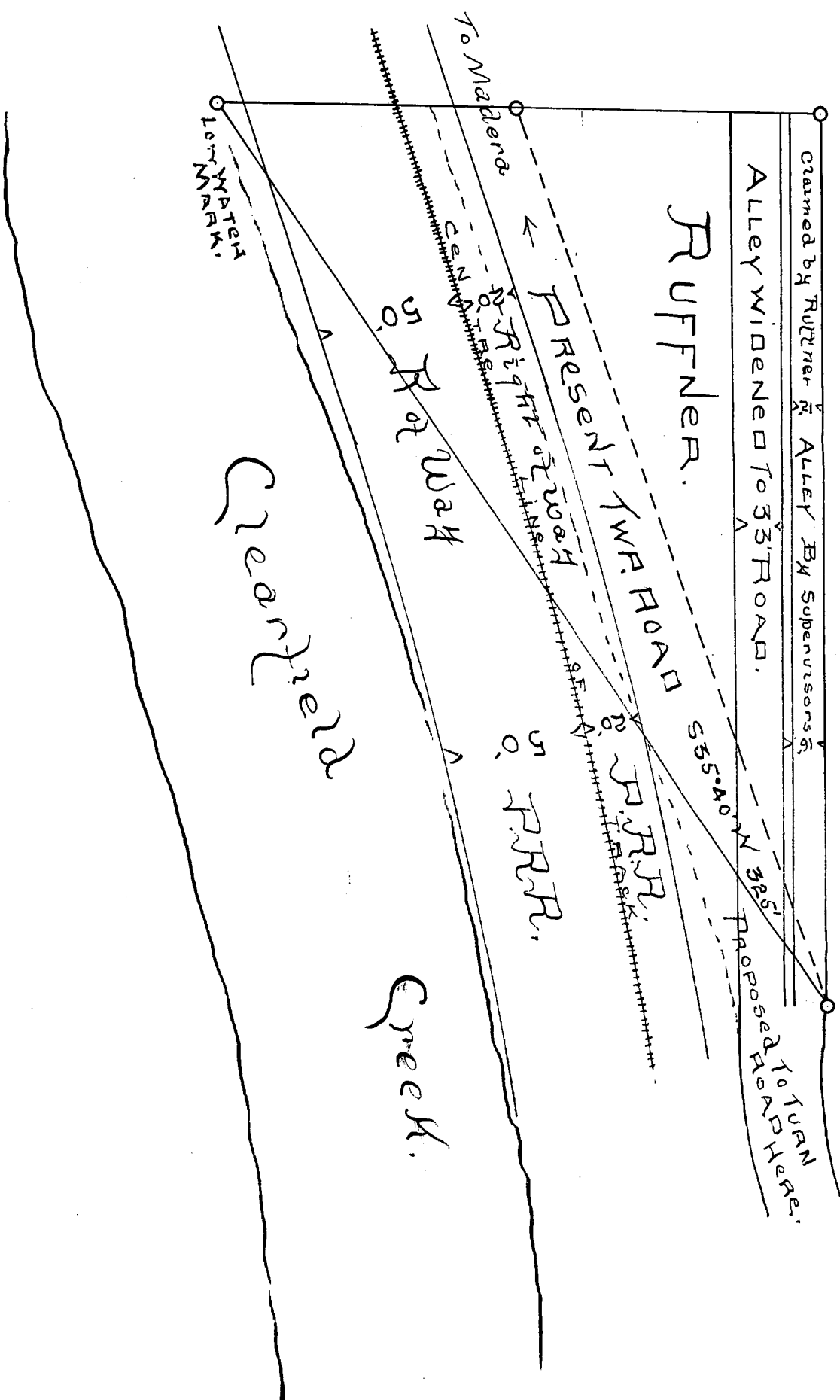
Therefore pray the Court to appoint Viewers to view and lay out such a road Beginning at a point on the aforesaid Turnp road at the line of J. H. Shoff and ending at a point of Intersection with the road leading from Houtzdale to Glen Hope at the North western corner of the Madera Hotel and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law, and make Report to the Court

whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Asa Spencer Wm Ricard and Robert McManara who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law, Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

I the Honorable the Court within mentioned; we the undersigned viewers appointed to ^{and supply} vacate the road within mentioned. Report that in pursuance of said order, having been severally sworn as here in directed and after the accustomed ten days notice and notice having been given County Commissioners as required by rule of Court we have viewed the road and in our judgment believe the old road to be entirely sufficient for the needs of all as a public road. [the same beginning at a point on the line of J. W. Shoff on the Dwp. Road from Sanion & Madera thence S 30° 40' W - 32 feet to point in Dwp road from Stonydale & Glen Hope] for the reason that the Pennsylvania Railroad Co. has purchased forty feet of ground from Peter Ruffner giving twenty to the Dwp for road and ~~keeping~~ twenty for Right of Way the granting the use of ten feet of said Right of Way if necessary (which it is not) the road being ample width and the expense great in changing same.
