To the Honorable, the Judge of the court of Quarter Sessions, of
1 Clearfield county... We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the
2 foregoing Order of Court, to View the site for a Bridge over the
3 East Branch of Mahoning creek, in Brady township, where the township
4 road leading from Troutville to Mahaffy crosses the same, do Report,
5 that first having given due notice of the time and place of meting,
6 by written and printed notices put up in the most conspicuous place
7 in the vicinity of said proposed view: we met, and having viewed the
8 premises, and have ascertained that a new Bridge is necessary at the
9 point above mentioned, where the Township road lhadng from Trout-
10 ville, to Mahaffy crosses the east branch of Mahoning creek, that it
11 will require a span at least fifty five feet, and we think the ex-
12 pense of building such a bridge as is necessary at this point would
13 be greater than could reasonably be be bourne by Brady township,
14 and we would recommend that the county should build the same, or as-
15 sist in the same. and that this report be respectfully presented
16 before the next Grand Jury.. We having previously to signing this
17 report, been duly Sworn and Affirmed...
