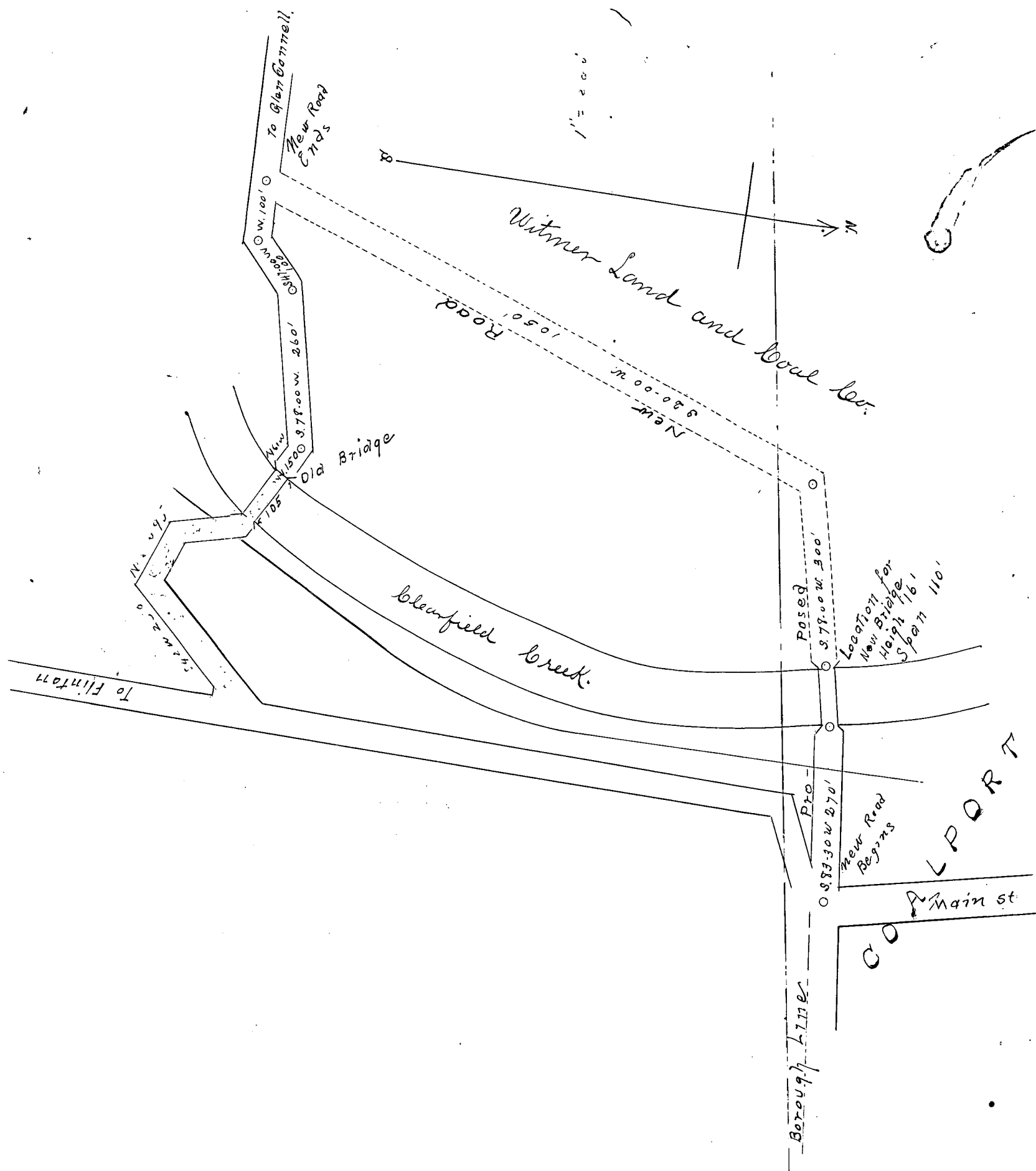
To the Hon. Cyrus Gordon,
Pres. Judge of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of Clearfield County Pa.
We the undersigned jurors
appointed by the within order
of Court to view the bridge
therein mentioned, Respect-
fully report.

That having given good
and lawful notice of said
bridge view with notice to
Commissioners of afore said County
we were present at view of
premises conformable to said
notices and having been severally
sworn or affirmed, we respect-
fully submit: That a new
bridge is needed where the
road from Calport to Glen
Hannell crosses Clearfield
Creek and that the cost thereof
is greater than is reasonable
that the Township should bear.
But it should not be placed
where the present structure is
located. We further report, that
the road should be changed so
as to reach the new location
of bridge, which proposed new

road and bridge are located as follows. Beginning in the center of Blaine street in Coalport Borough at the South end of Main Street where it is intersected by road to Tin Cornell. Thence by center of said Blaine Street South Eighty three degrees and thirty minutes West, two hundred and seventy feet to end of proposed bridge in Coalport Borough. Thence South seventy eight degrees West one hundred and ten feet to post on land of Wetzer Land and Lumber Co. in Pecaria Twp. which last course and distance we would recommend as the location for new bridge. Thence continuing South seventy eight degrees West through unimproved land of said Wetzer Land and Lumber Company three hundred feet to a post. Thence through the same South twenty degrees West one thousand and fifty feet to road now in use from Coalport to Tin Cornell at a point six hundred and one feet West of old bridge.

A plot or draft of which proposed bridge and road as laid out, showing courses and distances, improvements, etc is hereunto annexed. Which road as aforesaid laid out is necessary for a public road. We recommend that the bridge be sixteen feet high above low water. That Calport Borough build the East abutment and fill of approach with dirt taken from road to Flinton at point of hill near bridge to better the grade of said road. That Becharia Twp. build the west abutment and fill approach with material from hill at point aforesaid on road to Flinton. That the County Commissioners of Dearfield County appropriate the Superstructure to said district. Witness our hands this 20th day of November 1894.
