

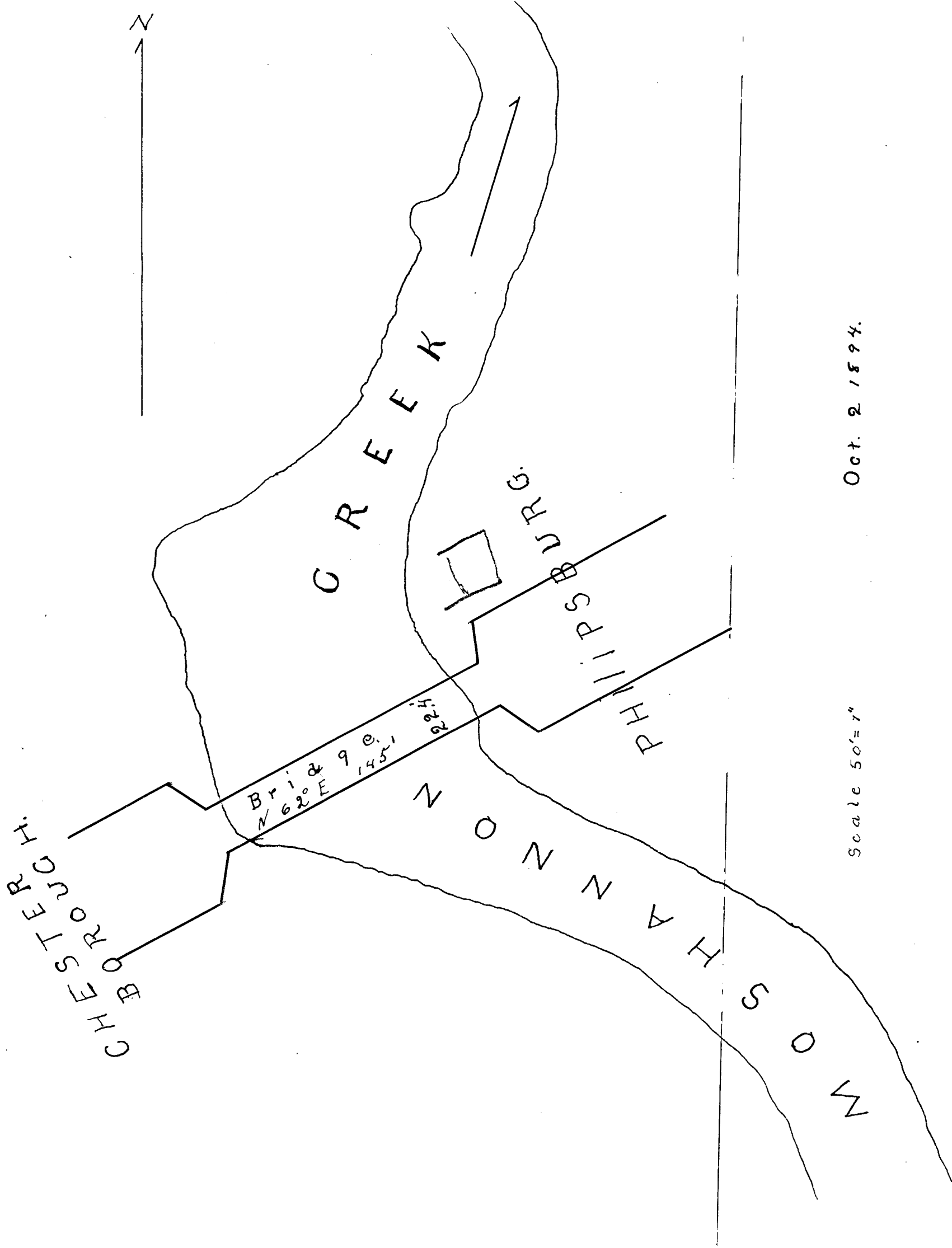

To the Honorable, the President Judge
of the Court of Quarter Sess of Clear-
field Co., Pa.

We the subscribers, who were appoint-
ed by your said Court, to view the place
proposed for the bridge in the within
order mentioned respectfully report:

That having given due notice as
required by law and having been first
severally sworn or affirmed we met
at the view of the place proposed for
the bridge on the second day of October
1894 together and in conjunction with
A. J. Graham, O. W. G. Drinn and Charles
Shaples, viewers, who were appointed by
the Court of Quarter Sess. of Centre Co.
for the said purpose and having view-
ed said premises we were of opinion
that a bridge over Moshannon Creek
at the place where the public high-
way or street known as Presque Isle
Street in the Borough of Chester Hill
crosses said Moshannon Creek and
joins the street known as Presque Isle
Street in the Borough of Philipsburg
Centre Co., Pa. is necessary and that
the erection of such a bridge would
be attended with more expense than
it is reasonable that the said Borough
of Chester Hill should bear. We
also append hereto a draft

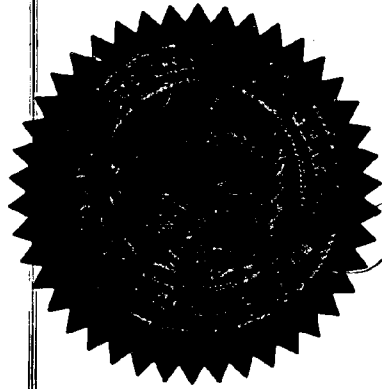

held at Clearfield on the 5th day of Sept
1894 Before the Honorable Cyrus Gordon
Presiding Judge of said County upon the
petition of the Counties of Clearfield & Centre
Respectfully representing that they are greatly
in need of a Bridge over Moshannon Creek
being the line of said Counties at the place
where the public Highway known as Perquies
street to the Borough of Philipsburg crosses
the said Moshannon Creek to the Borough
of Philipsburg crosses the said Moshannon
Creek in the Borough of Philipsburg in
Centre County and that the Erection of
said Bridge will require more Expense
than is reasonable the said Borough should
bear. Your petitioners therefore pray the
