That having given notice, of the
time, and place of Meeting, according to the
act of Assembly, and being all present at
the view of the ground proposed for the said
road, and being all sworn, in pursuance of the
said Order: We have viewed and laid out; and
do return the following Road to Wt. Beginning
at a Stone, which is the South East Corner of
land belonging to the Estate of J. J. Wagner. the
South West Corner of land belonging to Wilson
Hoover. the North East Corner of land belonging
to Leonard Kyler. and the North West Corner of
land belonging to a Mrs. Miller, and running
from thence, along the line between the said
Leonard Kyler, and Mrs Miller, and Gilbert Hoover.
between Gilbert Hoover, Peter Bodine, Nathan
Beam, and the Berg Brothers. Between,
Joseph Eisenhower, and Daniel Beam, and
between John Viedeffer, and James Little,
South four degrees, and forty five Minutes,
West. Six Hundred and forty perches, to the
Township Road. (S 4: 45' W. 640 ps)

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 11. day of Feb'y, A. D. 1895, before Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Cooper, in said County, setting forth that

They labor under great inconvenience for want of a Public road or highway to lead from a point on Public Road at or near the line of Property of John Dindiffer North to a point at or near South West Corner of Property of William Hoover and South East Corner of Property of J. F. Wagner

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law, And Make Report to next Term whereupon the Court, upon due consideration ~~and~~ of the premises, do order and appoint D. H. M. Closkey, A. J. Shields & D. H. Manning who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC ~~or PRIVATE~~ road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law, Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.
