To the Honorable, the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the County of Clearfield,

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants, Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of DuBois, respectfully represent.

That a bridge is much wanted over Sandy Lick Creek at a place where North Brady Street crosses said Creek in the Borough aforesaid, the bridge at that place now having become too narrow, for the reason a street car track crosses it and the traffic is so heavy an ordinary 16 foot bridge is not wide enough, besides only one foot walk of ~~four~~<sup>seven</sup> (7) wide is on it where one of eight (8) feet is necessary. And the expense of erecting said bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants of said Borough.

Your petitioner therefore pray your Honor to appoint proper persons to view the premises and to take such order on the subject as is required by the Act of General Assembly in such case made and provided .

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out  
the same according to law, ~~referred to next term~~  
whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and  
appoint Thos W Moore, W J Hoffer, Geo H Hall  
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their  
appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed  
for said ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup> and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers  
agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup>, they shall proceed to lay out the same  
agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best  
ground for a ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup> and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the  
least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the  
same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup>, together with a plot or draft  
of the same, ~~with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements~~  
~~through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from per-~~  
~~sons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such re-~~  
~~leases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof~~  
to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report  
they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law,  
Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through  
which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to  
the 147th Rule of Court.

as to the necessity of a bridge across Sandy Lick creek  
on North Brady Street in the Borough of Dubois  
Do Report that after having first given notice of  
our meeting five days of the time and place of meeting  
we all met and being duly affirmed according  
to Law. Have viewed the site for said proposed bridge  
and find that the bridge now spanning said creek  
on Brady Street in consequence of the widening of  
said Brady Street is found to be very much too narrow  
to accommodate the Public travel when said street  
is completed and whereas a bridge is now needed  
a short distance below on said creek near Fullers  
Mill we think and would recommend that the  
bridge now on Brady Street be removed and placed  
at the crossing near Fullers Mill on — street  
and that the County furnish a bridge of the proper  
width and have it erected where the present one
