That on the 10th day of September A.D. 1895 at 2 o'clock
P.M. which being the time appointed for said view,
did meet on the ground at the above described
place and after all having been duly affirmed
according to law, proceeded to fulfill the duties
named in said order and do respectfully
report that in our opinion a bridge at said
point is absolutely necessary and that the
said bridge should be a permanent structure
and do consider that the cost of erection of a bridge
such as would be suitable at this place would be
burdensome upon the inhabitants of said township,
therefore in our opinion the County of Clearfield
should aid in construction of said bridge.
