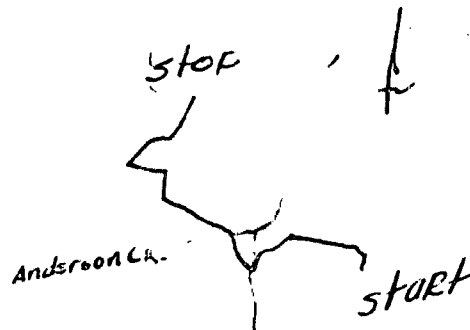

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the
county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clear-
field, in and for said county, on the 19
day of Sept, A. D. 1896 before
Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry
inhabitants of the township of Bloom and
Union, in said County, setting forth that

that they labor under under great
inconvenience for want of public
Road leading from point on
public Road from the viaduct
on C. M. R. R. to the Erie Turnpike
at or near S. E. La Borda in
Bloom Twp to a point in public
from Rockton to Erie Turnpike
near Stewart Askeys in
Union Twp

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out
the same according to law, & report to next term
whereupon the Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and
appoint Sam'l Myers & Wm. H. McKee
who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their
appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed
for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers
agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same
agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best
ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the
least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the
same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft
of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements
through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from per-
sons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such re-
leases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof
to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report
they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law,
Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through
which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to
the 147th Rule of Court.

To the Honorable Cyrus Gordon President Judge of the Court of Quarter Session 2 of Clearfield County Pa. we the undersigned viewers appointed by the within order of Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned respectfully report that we gave notice of said road view by posting notices in public places in vicinity of road and with three days notice to County Commissioners and met agreeable thereto on the thirtieth day of September and having been severally sworn or affirmed we have viewed and laid out and do return for public use the following road to wit: beginning at a point in public road leading from viaduct on the C & M R R to the Erie Turnpike at land of S. E. Saborde near his home. Thence by said road North thirty five perches thence North fifty three degrees West thirty perches thence through timber land of Dinslings & Co & J. B. Norris West one hundred twenty three perches to a post thence through woodland of said J. B. Norris South forty degrees West seven and six tenths perches to a post thence South fifty seven degrees West seven and six tenths perches to a Birch sapling thence South forty five degrees West seven and six tenths perches to a Hemlock thence South fifty and three fourth degrees West fourteen and eight tenths perches to a Hemlock thence through timber land of said Dinsling & Co South thirty two degrees West five and six tenths perches to a post thence through same and land of P. V. thence South twelve and one half degrees West twenty eight and two tenths perches to a post thence through woodland of same South twenty five degrees West across Little Anderson Creek into Union Township five and one tenth perches to a post thence North thirty degrees West fourteen and three tenths perches to post thence leaving Anderson Creek North fifty one and one half degrees West thirteen and two tenths perches to a Beech thence North thirty three degrees West twenty three and eight tenths perches to a Beech thence North twelve and three fourth degrees West sixteen perches crossing branch of Anderson Creek to post thence North seventy one and one fourth degrees West seventeen perches to post thence North sixty one degrees fifty minutes West twelve perches to post thence through land of Margaret Reutz and Jane Swoope North seventy one degrees forty minutes West one hundred twenty and eight tenths perches to a post thence through land of said Jane Swoope North one half degree West fifty five and five tenths perches to a Maple corner of land of H. S. Hollofeter and Geo. Shively and on line of Mrs. Jane Swoope thence by line of land of Jane Swoope being wood land and farm land of said George Shively West eighty and six tenths perches to road leading from Erie Turnpike to Rockton to Erie Turnpike thence by said road North thirty seven and one half degrees East fifty eight and six tenths perches thence North seventy nine and three one fourth degrees East thirty six perches thence North forty and three fourth degrees East sixteen perches thence North twenty two and three fourth East sixty four perches to point at land of Stewart Aubrey and near his house, a plot or draft of which road so as aforesaid laid out is herewith annexed showing courses distances and improvements, which road is necessary in our opinion for a public road, release of damages are annexed to this report. 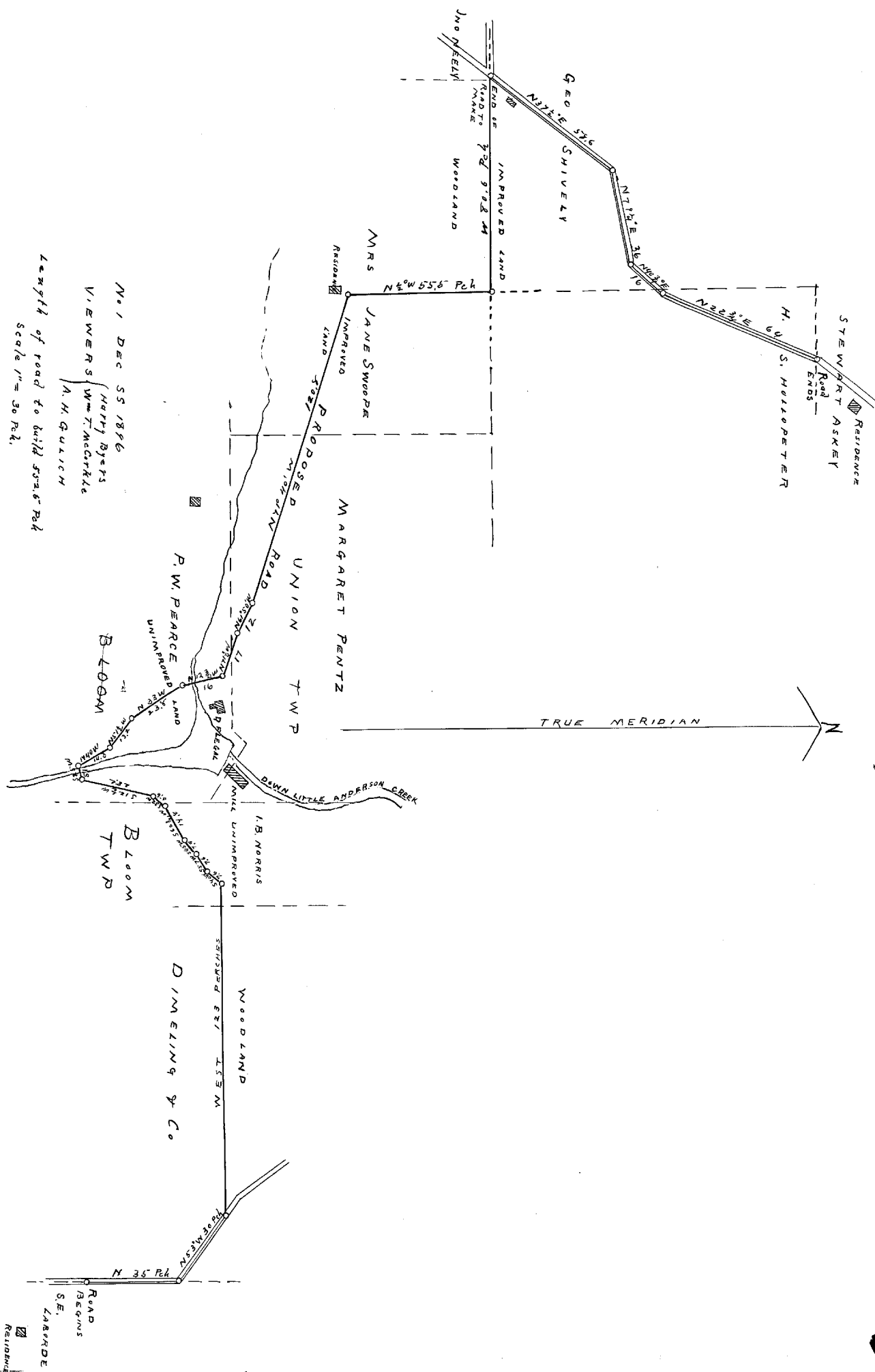
