The petition of the undersigned citizens of Lawrence

Spring and Fall is rendered impassable on account of the
high water and ice .- That there is a large amount of travel
over this road which is greatly inconvenienced for want of
better facilities in getting to the County seat .- That a bridge
at the point above named would shorten the distance more
than a mile besides giving them a good and safe road to travel
over
