At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said County, on the 12th. day of Sept. A. D. 1898, the Judge of said Court, upon a petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Graham, in said County, setting forth that a road had lately been ordered laid out from Public road leading to Wallacetown near E. K. Turners in Graham Township to a point near James B. Dunkels on road leading from Bigler to Allport which road if confirmed and laid out would be very injurious to said petitioners, and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and vacate the same according to law, whereupon the Court upon due consideration, do order and appoint Harry Reese, Patrick Curley, and Amos Hubler, who after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment impartially, with fidelity and according to the best of their judgment, are to view the road in said petition prayed to be vacated, and to consider and judge whether if laid out it would be useless, inconvenient and burdensome; and if they agree that the same would be useless, inconvenient and burdensome as aforesaid they shall make report accordingly to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County.

To the Honorable Cyrus Gordon, Judge of said Court.

We, the undersigned, viewers appointed by the within order of Court, to view the road therein mentioned, respectfully report; That we gave due public notice by three written and printed hand-bills or notices put up on and near the location of said road of the time and place of meeting to view the same, we met at the view of the said road on the premises on the 3d day of October A. D. 1898, and having all been first severally sworn or affirmed, in pursuance of the said order, we viewed the said road as heretofore laid out but not opened, being described as follows; Beginning at a point in public road leading to Wallaceton and near the residence of E. K. Turner; thence North 79 deg. East 1000 feet; thence North 66 deg. East 321 feet; thence North 75 deg. East 485 feet; thence North 68 deg. East 658 feet; thence North 76 deg. East 336 feet; thence North 68 deg. East 348 feet; thence North 75 deg. East 580 feet to a point in public road running from Bigler to Morrisdale near the residence of J. P. Dunkle which is the point of ending of said road. and we are of the opinion that the same if opened would be useless, inconvenient and burdensome, and ought therefore to be vacated.
