Clearfield County, ss:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the county of Clearfield, Pennsylvania, held at Clearfield, in and for said county, on the 9th day of May, A. D. 1898, before Judge of said Court, upon a petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Decatur,

in said county, setting forth that a part of the public road now laid out and opened in Decatur Dwp aforesaid leading from at or near Isaac Portman to at or near Adam Repharts is unnecessary and burdensome

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and ~~lay out~~ ^{measure} the same according to law,

whereupon the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Asa Spencer, John Wright & Miles Mase who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the grounds proposed for said road, and if they view the same and any two of the actual viewers agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property, and state particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a PUBLIC or PRIVATE road, together with a plot or draft of the same, with the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which it passes, and shall also procure releases of damages from persons through whose land said road may pass, or failing to procure such releases, shall assess the same, if any sustained, and shall make report thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, in which report they shall state that they have been sworn and affirmed according to law. Notice is directed to be given to the owners or occupants of seated land through which the within road is intended to pass, of the time of the view, according to the 147th Rule of Court.

To The Honorable, The Court within mentioned; we the undersigned, appointed to view, vacate and supply the Public Road herewith described Report, that in pursuance of said order, having been severally sworn as herein directed, and having given accustomed ten days notice and notice having been given the County Court Commissioners as required by rule of Court we have viewed and vacated the Public Road beginning at point near Isaac Britton and on Township road leading from Brisbin to Coal Run thence $864^{\circ} E$ 358 feet; thence $819^{\circ} E$ - 218 feet; thence $87^{\circ} E$ - 421 feet; thence $8110.5^{\circ} W$ - 800 feet; thence $81203^{\circ} W$ - 470 feet to point on Public Road near Adam Kephart. That we believe this Road to be burdensome on account of the expense required to keep same from closing & drifting, that during the winter months and that it is unnecessarily long and that the expense of maintaining and keeping open would meet the cost of construction of road supplies in a short time. That we further have been and laid out the road beginning at a point near Daniel Jones thence $8169^{\circ} W$ - 282 feet; thence $N 61^{\circ} 25' W$ 101 feet; thence $815045^{\circ} E$ - 900 feet to point on Public Road near residence of Burton Winters and that we believe the same necessary as a Public Road. And that a draught showing courses and distances of road vacated and Road supplied is herewith attached.

ages, taking into consideration the advantages as well as the
disadvantages of the road, they will report to that effect.


